

I am very pleased that the IDB just announced that Segue Software, Inc. has agreed to establish a software support center in Belfast. As you may know, we promoted the concept of Belfast as a software support capital when I went to Belfast in February and to Segue subsequently. Segue, in turn, agreed to go to Belfast in May. They were most impressed and did a deal with the IDB in just six months, which is indicative of the potential of this concept. Jim Lyons was very helpful with this process. I have spoken with Ellis Mottur of the Commerce Department about organizing a software trade mission to Northern Ireland featuring companies from Silicon Valley and Massachusetts, etc.

On a related subject, Frank Costello and I will be leading the first "Friends of Belfast" group to Belfast on October 17. We are very pleased that Mrs. Clinton became a "Friend of Belfast" when she was last in Belfast. Also, during that same week I will be participating in the Taoiseach's Ireland-America Economic Advisory Board mission to Ireland and hope to communicate what we are doing in Northern Ireland regarding job creation, economic development and cross-border initiatives.

As part of this trip, we will be organizing a Belfast Trade Festival to Boston featuring 42 Belfast companies in behalf of the Belfast City Council. The exposition will be held at the World Trade Center in Boston on November 21<sup>st</sup> through 25<sup>th</sup>. We understand that Secretary Daley will participate.

As you know, things of this nature are enormously important to people in Belfast and Northern Ireland and give them hope that things are indeed getting better. Finally, our efforts are really in support of your administration's remarkable commitment to peace in Northern Ireland.
