Dear Mr. President:

I am writing to express my sincere hope that you appoint a Special Peace Envoy to Northern Ireland. Throughout my ten years as a New York City Council Member, I have have lent my full support towards establishing a just and lasting peace in this troubled region.

While I in no way condone the violence perpetrated by terrorist groups, I also know that such groups exist because of the brutal and unjust nature of the British occupation.

Just as the United States has a vital role in settling bitter disputes in the Middle East, it also has a responsibility, as a world leader, to mediate the conflict in Northern Ireland.

I believe that appointing a Special Peace Envoy to Northern Ireland would send a clear and powerful signal to all interested parties in the region that the United States wants to end the terrible bloodshed there and is serious about doing so.
