SUBJECT: U.S. ECONOMIC INITIATIVE WELCOMED IN NORTHERN IRELAND

1. PRESIDENT CLINTONS ANNOUNCEMENT OF ECONOMIC AND INVESTMENT INITIATIVES HAS BEEN GENERALLY WELCOMED IN NORTHERN IRELAND. THE ECONOMY MINISTER, BARONESS DENTON SAID, "I THINK AMERICAS PACKAGE IS FULL OF WHAT WE NEED - SUPPORT, ACCESS, THE BENEFIT OF THEIR EXPERIENCE." SDLP LEADER JOHN HUME SAID THE ANNOUNCEMENT CONFIRMED THE PROMISES THE PRESIDENT HAD GIVEN TO BUILD ON THE PEACE. HUME SAID, "I DEEPLY APPRECIATE THE INVOLVEMENT WHICH THE PRESIDENT HAS SHOWN AND I AM VERY AWARE OF HIS WILLINGNESS TO HELP US ECONOMICALLY." SINN FEIN PRESIDENT GERRY ADAMS WELCOMED WHAT HE CALLED THE PRESIDENT CLINTONS PERSONAL COMMITMENT TO THE PEACE PROCESS. A SPOKESMAN FOR THE INTERNATIONAL FUND FOR IRELAND (IFI) WELCOMED THE NEWS THAT THE FUND WOULD BENEFIT BY AN ADDITIONAL TWENTY MILLION DOLLARS IN THE NEXT TWO YEARS. THE DEMOCRATIC UNIONIST PARTY, WHILE WELCOMING THE NEWS OF THE PRESIDENTS ANNOUNCEMENT, QUESTIONED THE CHANNELLING OF FUNDS THROUGH THE IFI. PARTY SECRETARY NIGEL DODDS SAID, "WE ARE CONCERNED ABOUT CHANNELLING EVEN MORE MONEY INTO THE DISCREDITED INTERNATIONAL FUND FOR IRELAND WHICH WAS SET UP TO BOLSTER THE ANGLO-IRISH AGREEMENT...ANY MONEY FROM AMERICA MUST BE USED OBJECTIVELY AND FAIRLY AND BE BALANCED ACROSS THE COMMUNITY IN NORTHERN IRELAND."

2. DR. GRAHAM GUDGIN, DIRECTOR OF THE NORTHERN IRELAND ECONOMIC RESEARCH CENTER, CLAIMED THAT THE AMOUNT WAS ONLY A TRICKLE IN COMPARISON TO AID RECEIVED BY OTHER COUNTRIES. AND, HE MAINTAINED, THE PRESIDENTS ANNOUNCEMENT OF INITIATIVES WAS TO COVER UP FOR THE FACT THAT NO REAL INVESTMENT IS TO COME FROM THE U.S. A SPOKESMAN FOR THE WORKERS PARTY, JOHN LOWRY, ECHOED THESE SENTIMENTS AND

CLAIMED THAT THE ANNOUNCEMENT WAS MORE OF AN ELECTION GIMMICK
ON THE PART OF THE DEMOCRATIC PARTY THAN A SERIOUS ATTEMPT AT
PLANNED INVESTMENT. OVERALL, HOWEVER, REACTION TO THE
ANNOUNCEMENT HAS BEEN WIDELY FAVORABLE.

1. THE NORTHERN IRELAND OFFICE IS BEING ACCUSED OF STALLING THE PEACE PROCESS BY ADMITTING IT MAY TAKE UP TO THREE YEARS TO OPEN ALL CROSS-BORDER ROADS. THE SDLPS DEPUTY LEADER, SEAMUS MALLON, SAID THE TIME SCALE WAS, "QUITE RIDICULOUS." "IF THIS WAS AN ARMY OR SECURITY MATTER, THEN IT WOULD BE DONE IMMEDIATELY, IRRESPECTIVE OF INCONVENIENCE TO THE COMMUNITY." MICHAEL MCPHILLIPS OF THE FERMANAGH-MONAGHAN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION SAID THE PEOPLE OF THE REGION WERE AT FIRST DELIGHTED TO HEAR THAT THE BORDER ROADS WOULD BE REOPENED. "THIS DELAY," HE SAID "HAS THROWN A SPANNER IN THE WORKS...AT THE MOMENT, PEOPLE LIVING IN THE LEITRIM-FERMANAGH AREA FACE A 29-MILE DRIVE FOR A 3-MILE JOURNEY." MITCHEL MCLAUGHLIN OF SINN FEIN SAID HE WILL BE RAISING THE ISSUE OF CROSS-BORDER ROADS WITH THE IRISH GOVERNMENT.

2. A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NIO SAID THAT ROADWORKS AT FIVE CROSSING POINTS HAD BEEN COMPLETED AND WORK THAT WAS IN HAND AT ANOTHER TWELVE. HE SAID THAT HE EXPECTED THE MAJORITY OF CROSSING POINTS TO BE REOPENED WITHIN SIX TO EIGHT MONTHS. "IT MAY, HOWEVER, TAKE SOME THREE YEARS TO COMPLETE THE PROGRAM BECAUSE OF THE NEED TO REPLACE ROAD BRIDGES ON SEVERAL OF THE ROUTES. THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT WILL BE WORKING CLOSELY WITH THE IRISH ROADS AUTHORITIES TO DEAL WITH ENGINEERING, DESIGN AND DRAINAGE ISSUES," HE SAID.

EMBASSY RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING LETTER FROM NORTHERN IRELAND SECRETARY SIR PATRICK MAYHEW TO THE PRESIDENT BY FAX ON NOVEMBER 7. WE UNDERSTAND IT WAS ALSO FAXED TO THE BRITISH EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON ON NOVEMBER 4, FOR DELIVERY TO THE WHITE HOUSE.

BEGIN TEXT:

DEAR MR. PRESIDENT:

I SHOULD LIKE TO EXPRESS OUR WARM WELCOME FOR YOUR ANNOUNCEMENT OF SUCH A GENEROUS PACKAGE OF U.S. ASSISTANCE FOR THE PROCESS OF PEACE AND RECONCILIATION IN NORTHERN IRELAND.

THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT IS MOST GRATEFUL FOR THE U.S. ADMINISTRATION'S SUPPORT FOR THE DEVELOPING PEACE PROCESS. YOUR GOVERNMENT'S ANNOUNCEMENT OF AN INCREASED CONTRIBUTION TO THE INTERNATIONAL FUND FOR IRELAND IN 1996 AND 1997 IS PARTICULARLY WELCOME.

I LOOK FORWARD KEENLY TO COMMERCE SECRETARY BROWN'S VISIT TO LFAST NEXT MONTH, AND TO YOUR OWN INVESTMENT ONFERENCE IN PHILADELPHIA NEXT SPRING.

THE PROSPECTS ARE BRIGHTER THAN WE COULD HAVE EXPECTED
EVEN A YEAR AGO, BUT THEY ARE STILL FAR FROM CERTAIN. I
HAVE NO DOUBT THAT YOUR ASSISTANCE, TOGETHER WITH THAT
FROM THE EU, IN SUPPORTING THE ENDEAVORS OF THE BRITISH
AND IRISH GOVERNMENTS, WILL HELP VERY VALUABLY TO
MAXIMIZE THE PROSPECTS OF A LASTING PEACE.

LOCAL POLITICIANS HAVE INDICATED THAT THEY ARE CONFIDENT THAT THE NORTHERN IRELAND PEACE PROCESS WILL NOT BE ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY THE COLLAPSE OF THE IRISH GOVERNMENT AND THE RESIGNATION OF PRIME MINISTER ALBERT REYNOLDS. THE VICE PRESIDENT OF SINN FEIN, PAT DOHERTY, SAID HIS PARTY WOULD WORK WITH "ALL PARTIES TOWARDS THE GOAL OF ...SECURING A JUST AND LASTING PEACE IN IRELAND." HIS PARTY PRESIDENT, GERRY ADAMS, HAD PREVIOUSLY INDICATED CONCERN FOR THE PROCESS SHOULD THE IRISH GOVERNMENT COLLAPSE. 1. THE ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY, DR. GEORGE CAREY, SPEAKING AT SERVICE FOR PEACE AND RECONCILIATION AT DUBLIN'S CHRIST CHURCH CATHEDRAL ATTENDED BY IRISH PRESIDENT MARY ROBINSON AND SINN FEIN VICE PRESIDENT PAT DOHERTY, SAID THE ENGLISH NEEDED "TO ASK FORGIVENESS FOR OUR OFTEN BRUTAL DOMINATION AND CRASS INSENSITIVITY IN THE 800 YEARS OF HISTORY OF OUR RELATIONSHIPS WITH IRELAND." ACCORDING TO A STORY IN THE NOVEMBER 19 IRISH TIMES NEWSPAPER, DR. CAREY, THE LEADER OF 70 MILLION ANGLICANS, MADE THESE REMARKS WHILE ON A FIVE-DAY VISIT TO IRELAND LAST WEEK.

2. DURING THE SAME SERMON, DR. CAREY ALSO GAVE A SOMBER VIEW OF THE PEACE PROCESS, WARNING THAT THERE REMAINED "A DARK FOREBODING IN THE AIR." HE CITED A RECENT RANDOM TELEVISION SURVEY IN WHICH FIVE OF THE EIGHT YOUNG PEOPLE INTERVIEWED IN NORTHERN IRELAND PREDICTED CIVIL WAR BEFORE THERE WOULD BE RECONCILIATION. QUOTING FROM A 1985 SPEECH BY CARDINAL DALY, HE SAID IT WAS NOT GOOD FOR POLITICS OR RELIGION IN THE NORTH "THAT TO BE BORN IN THE PROTESTANT FAITH SHOULD AUTOMATICALLY MEAN BEING BORN INTO A UNIONIST OR A LOYALIST POLITICAL PARTY AND THAT TO BE BORN IN THE CATHOLIC FAITH SHOULD AUTOMATICALLY MEAN BEING BORN INTO A NATIONALIST OR REPUBLICAN POLITICAL PARTY."
