

About the Author



William Hughes is a writer, radio commentator, attorney, activist, actor and native of Baltimore City.

For over twenty-five years, Mr. Hughes has been active in the cause of Irish freedom. In the early '70's, he joined the Baltimore Chapter of Irish Northern Aid. In the late '70's, Mr. Hughes also served as counsel and chairman of the Maryland State Chapter of the Irish National Caucus. He also was very active in the campaign to free the Irish freedom fighter, Joe Doherty.

Mr. Hughes has traveled to Ireland, north and south, ten times over the last two decades. He has testified about British human rights violations in the north of Ireland before Congressional, municipal and state panels. In December 1993, he joined a delegation of activists that went to the White House and, in an historic meeting, argued successfully for a visa for Sinn Fein's President, Gerry Adams.

In addition, Mr. Hughes spearheaded the passage of a MacBride Principles law by the Baltimore City Council in the spring of 1993. In recent years, he has worked on a *pro bono publico* basis in Washington, D.C., on behalf of the Irish American Unity Conference and the Lawyers Alliance for Justice in Ireland.

Presently, Mr. Hughes is a columnist for the *Baltimore Sentinel*. He also does a commentary for Pacifica's *Radio Free Eireann* program on WBAI (99.5 fm) in New York City. He is a member of AFTRA/SAG unions and has appeared in over 20 movies, TV commercials, industrial films and many stage productions.


