Dear Mr. President:

We are writing to urge you once again to appoint a special envoy to Northern Ireland. We were heartened by your pledge during the presidential campaign to work for peace in Northern Ireland, and believe that now is the time to act on that pledge. In light of the signing of the declaration of principles by Irish Prime Minister Albert Reynolds and British Prime Minister John Major, an envoy is needed now more than ever.

We are hopeful that all parties to the conflict will take advantage of this opportunity for negotiations, but we believe that the agreement should be seen as no more than a first step. While it contains many positive statements, the plan outlines no definite proposals for bringing about peace and no specific timeframe for initiating negotiations.

Appointing a special envoy to Northern Ireland will help advance the process of negotiations. We urge you to do this immediately so as to not allow this step toward peace in Northern Ireland to go to waste.
