





Summary of Conclusions

It was agreed that:

- Belgrade's announcement of a "cease-fire" was insufficient and did not meet agreed conditions for NATO to cease its military operations. This should be announced publicly, and we should urge our allies and the NATO Secretary General to do the same. (Action: All) (S)

- As we approach Orthodox Easter, Principals should consider three options:
  - sustaining NATO's bombing campaign;
  - a short "challenge" pause, during which we would insist on a real cease-fire, access for humanitarian relief and acceptance of NATO's conditions; this might be combined with dispatch of an envoy to Belgrade; and
  - a short "goodwill" pause, without any conditions, in respect for Orthodox Easter. (Action: All) (~~S~~)
- Any pause should be portrayed as a NATO initiative rather than as a response to Belgrade's "peace offensive." For either type of pause, resumption would need to be automatic if our full conditions were not met. (Action: All) (~~S~~)
- In the meantime, we should discourage public or allied discussion of "pauses" and maintain a public posture of skepticism about Belgrade's "peace offensive." (Action: All) (~~S~~)
- Principals should meet again to consider (1) the nature of a possible agreement with the FRY and (2) alternative strategies if NATO air operations do not result in an agreement. (Action: NSC) (~~S~~)





Sandy:

You asked if a Roberts report would be required with respect to use of Task Force Able Sentry and ARRC (Allied Rapid Reaction Corps) to assist with the humanitarian situation at the Macedonian border. I have consulted with JCS/Legal, which has queried J-3 on the facts.

Answer:

No Report Required at this time. The U.S. personnel participating in relief efforts are covered under the March 25 Roberts report. (Their humanitarian efforts were obviously not described at that time; however, DOD/JCS can brief this to the Hill; we need not send another report covering the same forces).

JCS indicated that current plans, or plans under development, do not include deployments that would require an additional Roberts report. (Nor is Eric aware of any plans that would.)

#### If Requirements

Subsequently Change. EUCOM may change its view or the facts may drive planning in a different direction. Defense/JCS lawyers are watchful for Roberts thresholds and will ensure a draft is generated in the event of a triggering plan of action.

#### Emergency Exception.

Policymakers should also recall that if events outstrip the planning and report writing process, and an immediate dead-start deployment is required, there is an emergency exception to Roberts in cases where the President determines there to be "an emergency necessitating immediate deployment of the forces." This can be done orally or in writing. If done orally, NSC staff should record that he has done so, and DOD/JCS should subsequently brief the Hill on the deployment.

Summary of Conclusions

It was agreed that:

- The USG should work closely with the Kosovo Liberation Army to promote full compliance with its undertakings on demilitarization. (Action: State) (C)
- The USG should work with the UN to expedite the recruitment and deployment of personnel for the UN Interim Administration Mission in Kosovo (UNMIK). (Action: State, USUN) (U)
- The USG should redouble its efforts to secure Congressional agreement to release funding for the U.S. contribution to UNMIK's budget and international police force. (Action: All) (U)
- The USG should use its planned contribution to the July 28 Immediate Needs Conference to leverage contributions from other donors, while avoiding a contribution that exceeds a "fair share" of identified requirements. (Action: State, NSC) (U)
- The USG should consider contributing to the UN Trust Fund for Kosovo in order to support the costs of local public administration. (Action: State, OMB) (U)
- The USG should quickly complete work on a southeast Europe (SEE) investment climate initiative and trade initiative for the July 30 Stability Pact Summit in Sarajevo. Secretary Albright should contact her counterparts to urge that the summit produce concrete results in these areas. (Action: NEC, Treasury, State) (U)
- The USG should independently develop an estimate of funding requirements for the US contribution to SEE development so that these requirements can be reflected in an early fall amendment to the FY00 request together with revised defense requirements associated with KFOR. (Action: State, USAID, Treasury, OMB) (U)
- Consideration should be given to bringing the Russian Federation into the High-Level Steering Group responsible for guiding the donor coordination process for Kosovo and SEE;

while Russian participation could begin in September, no commitments should be made at this time. (Action: State, Treasury) (C)

- The USG should support a narrow definition of "humanitarian assistance" for Serbia. Any additional assistance to local communities controlled by opposition leaders should be carefully targeted, coordinated with the Europeans and conditioned on the local leaders committing to greater unity within the democratic opposition. (Action: State) (C)
