Scope and Content

FOIA 2020-0438-F is a request for all video recordings of Kenny G.

Kenneth Bruce Gorelick, known by his stage name of Kenny G, is a saxophonist that performed at various events during the Clinton administration. The events include a Saxophone Club event on June 28th, 1993, an event at Ford's Theatre (only the reception was photographed by the White House Television Office unit) on October 30th, 1994, and a Governors' Dinner on February 27th, 2000.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Video Recordings of the White House Television Office and the series therein – Video Recordings Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the individual item level. While this method retains tape run time integrity for video, it frequently results in the incidental processing of video that is not wholly responsive to the subject area.
