SUBJECT: STORM OVER NORTHERN IRELAND POLICE PROPOSALS

1. SUMMARY: PROPOSALS FLOATED BY ULSTER UNIONIST LEADER DAVID TRIMBLE RECENTLY THAT THE ROYAL ULSTER CONSTABULARY

CHIEF CONSTABLE SHOULD BE MADE ACCOUNTABLE TO AN ELECTED ASSEMBLY, HAVE ANGERED THE NORTHERN IRELAND POLICE

AUTHORITY. (THE POLICE AUTHORITY IS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE RUC AND COMPRISES 20 MEMBERS.) CHAIRMAN DAVID COOK WARNED THE GOVERNMENT TO BE QEXTREMELY CAREFULQ IN MAKING ANY CHANGES TO POLICE ACCOUNTABILITY. END SUMMARY.

2. POLICE AUTHORITY FEARS: POLICE AUTHORITY CHAIRMAN COOK VOICED HIS FEARS ON POLICE ACCOUNTABILITY AT A MAJOR CONFERENCE ON POLICING IN NEWCASTLE ON OCTOBER 10. MR. COOK, WHO HAS CLASHED WITH THE CHIEF CONSTABLE OVER MANY POLICY MATTERS IN THE PAST, SAID THERE SHOULD BE A QFIRM COMMITMENT TO HAVING AN AUTHORITY WITH CLEAR, LEGALLY DEFINED POWERS TO EFFECTIVELY REGULATE THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE POLICE AND THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE. WE MUST HAVE A POLICE SERVICE WHOSE LEADERS ARE PREPARED TO BE PROPERLY ACCOUNTABLE TO THE COMMUNITY THEY POLICE; WHO SEEK THE CONSENT AND COOPERATION OF ALL SECTIONS OF THAT COMMUNITY; AND WHO WILL PLAY A FULL PART IN MAKING SURE THAT PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE POLICE AND THE POLICED IS A CONSTRUCTIVE AND COOPERATIVE ONE...WE MUST NOT CREATE A POLICING FRAMEWORK, ESPECIALLY IN A DIVIDED SOCIETY, WHERE THE POLICE SERVICE IS AT THE BECK AND CALL OF POLITICAL PARTIES; WHERE A MINISTER OR AN ASSEMBLY COMMITTEE COULD DIRECT AND DEPLOY IT FOR POLITICAL OR SECTARIAN ADVANTAGE;

WHERE OFFICERS WOULD FEEL OBLIGED TO POLITICAL MASTERS IN DECIDING HOW TO DO THEIR JOB; OR WHERE THEY WERE DEPENDENT ON POLITICAL PATRONAGE FOR PROMOTION.Q

3. THE ALLIANCE VIEW: AFTER TALKS ON POLICING WITH STORMONT SECURITY MINISTER SIR JOHN WHEELER, ALLIANCE PARTY CHIEFS STEPPED UP THEIR CALL FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A JUSTICE COMMITTEE IN A POWER-SHARING ASSEMBLY. PARTY CHAIRMAN STEVE MCBRIDE SAID ACCOUNTABILITY WAS A KEY ELEMENT IN ANY NEW STYLE OF POLICING . QWE MUST TAKE THE VIEW THAT PART OF THAT ACCOUNTABILITY MUST INVOLVE A SIGNIFICANT ROLE FOR ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES OF THE COMMUNITY,Q MCBRIDE SAID. HE SAID AN ASSEMBLY JUSTICE COMMITTEE WOULD QFIT THE BILL.Q THE ALLIANCE PARTY ALSO ARGUED FOR LEGISLATION TO CREATE AN INDEPENDENT TRIBUNAL TO DECIDE THE ISSUE OF CONTROVERSIAL MARCHES.

4. SDLP: ALTHOUGH THE SDLP HAS NOT COMMENTED ON THIS LATEST ROW ON POLICING, ITS ATTITUDE TOWARD TRIMBLEQS PROPOSED ASSEMBLY REMAINS HIGHLY NEGATIVE. TRIMBLE RECENTLY DESCRIBED SDLP LEADER JOHN HUME AS QTHE FLY IN THE OINTMENT,Q AND AS A BARRIER TO PROGRESS IN TERMS OF A NEW ASSEMBLY. IN AN INTERVIEW IN THE OCTOBER 9 EDITION OF THE UNIONIST QNEWS LETTER,Q TRIMBLE SAID THAT, DESPITE SOME FAVORABLE RUMBLINGS FROM WITHIN THE SDLP, HUME HAD YET TO BE CONVINCED. TRIMBLE INSISTED THAT HIS PLAN WAS NOT A DEVICE FOR AN QINTERNAL SOLUTIONQ TO NORTHERN IRELANDQS PROBLEMS, AND THAT HUMEQS RESISTANCE TO IT DISAPPOINTED HIM. QSINN FEIN HAS NOT SAID IT IS IN FAVOR OF AN ASSEMBLY BUT IT HAS NOT BEEN AS EMPHATIC AS THE SDLP IN ITS REJECTION OF IT. WE HAVE A PROBLEM WITH HUMEQS TENDENCY TO MAKE SNAP JUDGMENTS AND THEN CLOSE HIS MIND,Q TRIMBLE COMPLAINED. STEPHENS

SUBJECT: REACTION TO MAYHEW'S OCTOBER 17 REMARKS.

1. SUMMARY: SIR PATRICK MAYHEW'S OCTOBER 17
STATEMENTS ARE BEING WIDELY INTERPRETED IN

BELFAST AS PRESAGING A BRITISH SHIFT IN ITS POSITION
ON THE QUESTION OF DECOMMISSIONING TERRORIST

WEAPONS. THE DEMOCRATIC UNIONISTS EXPRESSED
THEIR ANGER AT WHAV THEY CALLED THE GOVERNMENT
"CLIMBDOWN." SINN FEIN GAVE MAYHEW'S REMARKS A
CAUTIOUS WELCOME. END SUMMARY.

2. MAYHEW INDICATED AT A PRESS CONFERENCE AFTER
THE LATEST ROUND OF THE ANGLO-IRISH CONFERENCE IN
BELFAST THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WAS WILLING
TO ADOPT A TWIN-TRACK APPROACH TO THE ISSUE OF
DECOMMISSIONING IRA AND LOYALIST WEAPONS. THE
SECRETARY OF STATE SAID THAT CONFIDENCE WAS THE
KEY TO PROGRESS AND THAT THE SHADOW OF THE GUN
AND BOMB SHOULD NOT FALL ACROSS THE TALKS TABLE.
IN A BID TO END THE PRESENT IMPASSE IN THE PEACE
PROCESS, SIR PATRICK SAID, "IT IS THEORETICALLY
POSSIBLE THAT AN INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION MIGHT
FIND SOME OTHER MEANS BY WHICH THE NECESSARY
CONFIDENCE CAN BE GUARANTEED. IF THAT WAS THE
CASE, AND WE CAN'T SEE IT AT THE MOMENT, WE WOULD
WANT TO LOOK AT IT VERY CLOSELY." AT THE SAME
TIME, THE BRITISH AND IRISH GOVERNMENTS WOULD
HOLD TALKS WITH ALL PARTIES TO FIND A WAY
FORWARD. SIR PATRICK DENIED CLAIMS THAT THE

BRITISH GOVERNMENT WAS CHANGING TACK.
DECOMMISSIONING WAS STILL THE BEST WAY OF
ACHIEVING A PEACEFUL SETTLEMENT.

3. POLITICAL REACTION: SIR PATRICK'S REMARKS BROUGHT SWIFT CONDEMNATION FROM THE DEMOCRATIC UNIONISTS. PARTY LEADER IAN PAISLEY DESCRIBED THEM AS A "CLIMBDOWN" AND SAID THE IDEA OF AN ALTERNATIVE TO THE SURRENDER OF WEAPONS WAS A "GIANT LIE...THE GOVERNMENT, UNDER PRESSURE FROM DUBLIN AND THE IRA, ARE ACTIVELY ENGAGED IN GIVING GROUND TO THE IRA. THEY MAY BE ABLE TO FIND A FORM OF WORDS THAT SUIT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE IRA/SINN FEIN BUT MERE WORDS WILL NOT CONVINCE ANY UNIONIST THAT THE IRA INTENDS TO EVEN START A DECOMMISSIONING PROCESS. THE ULSTER UNIONIST DEPUTY LEADER, JOHN TAYLOR, SAID THE NOTION OF A TWIN-TRACK APPROACH WAS "SILLY NONSENSE." HOWEVER, HE SAID HIS PARTY WOULD ADOPT A WAIT-AND-SEE APPROACH TO THE PROPOSED INTERNATIONAL COMMISSION ON ARMS. RESPONDING TO DUP ACCUSATIONS OF A CLIMBDOWN, STORMONT MINISTER MICHAEL ANCRAM SAID THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT HAD NOT ALTERED ITS POSITION ON DECOMMISSIONING. IT WAS STILL THE GOVERNMENT'S VIEW THAT THERE SHOULD BE SOME MOVEMENT TOWARDS CREDIBLE DECOMMISSIONING BEFORE ALL-PARTY TALKS COULD GO AHEAD. AT A RECEPTION IN STRABANE IN COUNTY TYRONE LATER, MAYHEW SAID THAT THERE HAD BEEN NO CHANGE IN GOVERNMENT POLICY AND THAT DISARMAMENT MUST BEGIN BEFORE THERE CAN BE ALL-PARTY TALKS. HE BLAMED THE PRESS FOR MISREPORTING HIS OCTOBER 17 STATEMENT.

4. SINN FEIN CHAIRMAN MITCHEL MCLAUGHIN GAVE THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S ANNOUNCEMENT A GUARDED WELCOME. "CLEARLY, WHAT IS REQUIRED TO MOVE THE PEACE PROCESS FORWARD IS THE FIXING OF A DATE FOR ALL-PARTY TALKS AND THE REMOVAL OF PRECONDITIONS TO THOSE TALKS. SINN FEIN IS PREPARED TO LOOK POSITIVELY AT ANY FORMULA WHICH WILL MOVE THE SITUATION FORWARD IN THIS CONTEXT." MCLAUGHLIN SAID SINN FEIN HAD NO ROOM TO MANEUVER ON THE ISSUE OF IRA DECOMMISSIONING ARMS. LATER, A SINN FEIN SPOKESPERSON SAID THAT WHILE THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S REMARKS SHOWED SOME FLEXIBILITY, HIS POSITION WAS ALMOST AS HARD AS IT WAS A FEW DAYS AGO WHEN HE STUCK FIRMLY TO THE WASHINGTON PRECONDITIONS FOR ALL-PARTY TALKS.

AS ANTICIPATED IN REF A, THE IRISH GOVERNMENT ON NOVEMBER 6 GRANTED EARLY RELEASE TO ANOTHER FOUR IRA PRISONERS, BRINGING TO 36 THE TOTAL NUMBER OF IRA PRISONERS THAT HAVE RECEIVED EARLY RELEASE SINCE LAST YEAR'S IRA CEASEFIRE. BUT IN AN ODD TURN OF EVENTS, TWO OF THE FOUR - - NESSAN QUINLIVAN AND PEARSE MCAULEY -- WERE IMMEDIATELY RE-ARRESTED BASED ON LONG-STANDING EXTRADITION WARRANTS FROM THE UK. ACCORDING TO A JUSTICE DEPARTMENT SPOKESWOMAN, BOTH MEN SHOT THEIR WAY OUT OF THE UK'S BRIXTON PRISON IN JULY 1991 WHILE AWAITING TRIAL ON A NUMBER OF CHARGES, INCLUDING CONSPIRACY TO MURDER AND CONSPIRACY TO CAUSE MALICIOUS WOUNDING. AFTER ESCAPING, QUINLIVAN AND MCAULEY EVENTUALLY MADE THEIR WAY TO THE REPUBLIC, WHERE THEY WERE ARRESTED BY IRISH AUTHORITIES IN APRIL 1993 FOR FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVE OFFENSES COMMITTED IN IRELAND. CONVICTED IN THE REPUBLIC'S SPECIAL CRIMINAL COURT, QUINLIVAN WAS DUE OUT IN APRIL 1996 AND MCAULEY IN JULY 1998. FOLLOWING THEIR RE-ARREST, THE TWO MEN WERE REMANDED INTO CUSTODY FOR A WEEK WHILE BRITISH AUTHORITIES PURSUE EXTRADITION.
2. THE OTHER TWO MEN RELEASED WERE MARK FARRELL AND GERARD KEARNS. FARRELL HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF A NOVEMBER 1990

ARMED ROBBERY IN DUBLIN AND WAS NOT DUE FOR RELEASE UNTIL DECEMBER 1998. KEARNS WAS PART OF A SIX-MAN GANG WHO ROBBED A BANK IN ENNISCORTHY, COUNTY WEXFORD IN MAY 1990. CONVICTED OF USING FIREARMS TO RESIST ARREST, HE WAS NOT UP FOR NORMAL RELEASE UNTIL MAY 1999.

3. KEEPING WITH PAST PRACTICE, THE FOUR MEN WERE RELEASED "ON THE BASIS THEY WILL KEEP THE PEACE AND BE OF GOOD BEHAVIOR AND THAT THEY WILL NOT, THROUGH PUBLICITY OR OTHERWISE, DO ANYTHING WHICH MIGHT CAUSE ANNOYANCE OR DISTRESS TO ANY PERSON (OR TO THE FAMILY OR FRIENDS OF ANY PERSON) WHO MAY HAVE BEEN AFFECTED BY THE OFFENSE(S) WHICH LED TO THEIR IMPRISONMENT."

4. COMMENT: THIS IS THE FIFTH SEPARATE EARLY RELEASE OF IRA PRISONERS SINCE LAST YEAR'S IRA CEASEFIRE. THE LAST RELEASE WAS ON JULY 28, WHEN 12 WERE SET FREE (REF B). COUNTING QUINLIVAN AND MCAULEY AS "RELEASED," THIS TRANCHE LEAVES 41 "SUBVERSIVE" PRISONERS BEHIND BARS -- 21 IRA, 5 INLA, 2 IRB (IRISH REPUBLICAN BROTHERHOOD) AND 13 "UNALIGNED" INMATES. FURTHER RELEASES WILL BE DIFFICULT AND INCREASINGLY CONTROVERSIAL BECAUSE MOST OF THE "MINOR OFFENDERS" (THOSE CONVICTED MERELY OF IRA/INLA/IRB MEMBERSHIP OR POSSESSION OF WEAPONS AND/OR EXPLOSIVES) HAVE ALREADY BEEN RELEASED. SO FAR, THERE HAS BEEN AN UNSTATED RULE THAT IRA PRISONERS CONVICTED OF MURDER OR ATTEMPTED MURDER OF A POLICE OFFICER OR SOLDIER WILL NOT BE RELEASED EARLY. BUT IF THE GOVERNMENT WANTS TO CONTINUE ITS EARLY RELEASE PROGRAM, IT WILL SOON HAVE TO RE-CONSIDER THIS POLICY. END COMMENT. SMITH
