Northern Ireland Peace Process -- Letter to Bruce Morrison

Purpose

To respond to a letter from Federal Housing Finance Board Chairman Bruce Morrison congratulating you on the Irish peace process.

Background

Bruce Morrison wrote to congratulate you on your leadership in the Irish peace process. He noted in particular the decision to grant Adams a visa waiver as crucial to the sequence of events that led to Sinn Fein voting to support the Good Friday Accord. Morrison is keenly interested in all aspects of U.S.-Irish issues, and has been interested in being considered as ambassador to Ireland.

Your response thanks Morrison both for his letter and for his contributions to the peace process.
