Dear President Clinton,

It has come to my attention that you are forming a fact-finding committee to study the complex issues affecting the people living in northeastern Ireland. Certainly, such an effort by our government to bring peace with justice to that long suffering area is well overdue.

Based on my personal observations, supported in a large part by Amnesty International, the Helsinki Commission on Human Rights and other knowledgeable persons and organizations, I am certain that there is an organized institutional effort, by the military/colonial occupiers of that region, to obfuscate issues and to resist reasonable inclusive compromise.

Accordingly, in order to assure the success of its mission, it is essential that your investigative committee be broad based, balanced, and open to input from all parties.

Consequently, I urge you to expand the fact-finding committee and include Congressional Representatives Eliot L. Engel, Hamilton Fish, Ben Gilman and Tom Manton as members. All of these congresspersons are members of the Ad Hoc Congressional Committee on Irish Affairs.

Thank you for the energy and effort you have devoted to this matter.
