Dear Mr. President:

I am writing to express my support for your continued efforts to encourage the peace process in Ireland.

I am proud to say that the United States has played a pivotal role as peace promoter and mediator between Northern Ireland and the British Government, since the cease fire nearly one year ago. I hope that these efforts will continue until a fair agreement has been reached.

Our continued support for this process is crucial. We must encourage both sides to engage in all inclusive talks without pre-conditions, and move beyond the steps already taken. The United States is in a unique position to facilitate a lasting peace accord in this troubled region, and we have a responsibility to make every effort to bring about an agreement.

I am concerned about the current impasse in the peace process. I urge you to encourage both sides to lay aside the obstacles to continued peace talks. Further delay could endanger the entire peace process.

Again, I congratulate you on the initiative that you have taken to encourage peace in the region, and I urge you to continue to take courageous steps toward this end.
