The President has invited Prime Minister Albert Reynolds TD, to the White House. On March 17, the Taoiseach will meet with the President to present him the traditional bowl of shamrocks to mark St. Patrick's Day. That evening, the President will host the Taoiseach at a gala celebration at the White House. The celebration will honor the Taoiseach and celebrate Irish American heritage. The President looks forward to reviewing with the Taoiseach in the course of the visit the full range of issues on which our two countires cooperate so closelly, in particular the status of the efforts of the Prime Ministers of the Republic of Ireland and the United Kingdom to bnring peace to Northern Ireland.

Special Relationship

Q: Aren't the President's gestures toward John Major -- overnight at the White House, trip to Pittsburgh -- simply face-saving tokens to the British to cover up the fact that this Administration is, at best, indifferent to maintaining the so-called special relationship with Great Britain?

A: When John Major visited the White House last February, President Clinton was asked the same question. The President was clearly speaking from his heart when he said that as long as he is President, the relationship between the U.S. and Britain will indeed be special.

Over the past year, as we have wrestled with issues such as Bosnia, reform in Russia, the Uruguay Round, NATO's relevance, all of us on this side of the Atlantic have experienced time and again what that "special relationship" really means.

It does not always mean, as the media has been quick to seize on, that we always agree. It does mean that we talk to each other, often, in many fora, and that we do not shrink from asking each other tough questions on the toughest issues. It means that we enjoy an unmatched community of interests, values, and perspectives, and we know it.

Gerry Adams

Q: Did you get the results you sought by giving Gerry Adams a visa? What role will the U.S. now play in helping move the process forward? We've heard Adams has been invited to attend the St. Patrick's Day Parade in San Francisco, will the U.S. give him a visa if he requests one?

A: The President made a tough decision to grant Gerry Adams a waiver for a limited visa to attend the New York conference on Northern Ireland. We hope Sinn Fein and the IRA will renounce violence. We still believe strongly in the Joint Declaration and the framework it lays out for peace. We

continue to call on all parties to lay down arms and join the process outlined by the British and Irish governments in the Joint Declaration.

Adams has not asked for a visa for the San Francisco event.

(If Pressed on another visa for Adams) I simply won't speculate.

Pittsburgh

Q: What can you tell us about the President and Prime Minister's visit to Pittsburgh?

A: Schedules are not yet fixed and details are not yet final.

Defense Sales to Argentina

Q: Why did the U.S. decide to sell Argentina 36 A-4 aircraft with modern radar? Don't these airplanes pose a threat to British forces stationed in the Falklands?

A: We are selling these A-4s to allow Argentina to meet its legitimate defense needs. We believe the level of technology represented by the A-s meet those defense needs without upsetting the regional arms balance.

(If pressed) We do not believe that these A-4s pose a threat to British forces in the Falklands. We are aware of British security concerns surrounding the Falklands, and these concerns are taken seriously in our decisions.

CivAir

Q: Is the U.S. planning to renounce its civil aviation agreement with the UK?

A: In April 1993, Transportation Secretary Pena and UK Transport Secretary MacGregor agreed to negotiate by March 1994 a new civair agreement that would fully liberalize our civair relationship with the UK.

We have been negotiating with the UK since then. We want to make a deal. Renunciation is not an attractive option. We don't it to become the only one.

Q: How can the U.S. restrict British Airways' codesharing with USAir when the U.S. granted the UK unlimited codesharing rights for its airlines as part of the Heathrow succession agreement.

A: You should direct this question to DOT.

[FYI: Decisions regarding whether or not to extend codesharing rights falls to Secretary Pena.]

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb 23 (Reuter) - The FBI said Wednesday it had arrested an alleged Irish nationalist guerrilla who was involved in a mass breakout from a Northern Ireland prison in 1983.

FBI agents arrested Terence Damien Kirby, also known as Paul Kerr, Wednesday in Concord, 30 miles (50 km) east of San Francisco, the FBI said in a statement.

It said Kirby, 37, was one of 38 prisoners who escaped in September 1983 from Northern Ireland's Maze prison, where he was serving a life sentence for murder.

Kirby is the fourth Maze escapee arrested in California in the last two years.

Three others -- James Smyth, Pol Brennan and Kevin Artt -- are waiting for courts to decide on British requests to extradite them to serve out their sentences in Northern Ireland.

The four are alleged to be members of the Irish Republican Army (IRA), which is fighting to end British rule in Northern Ireland.
