1. JEAN, THANK YOU FOR YOUR RECENT MESSAGE UPON THE OCCASION OF MY APPOINTMENT AS SECRETARY OF COMMERCE AND YOUR KIND WORDS.
2. I KNOW THAT YOU WORKED CLOSELY AND PERSONALLY WITH RON BROWN AND CHUCK MEISSNER, AND THAT YOU SUPPORTED AND ADMIRING THE COMMITMENT THAT THEY BOTH BROUGHT TO SUPPORTING THE PEACE PROCESS IN NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE BORDER COUNTIES OF IRELAND. WE HAVE LOST VALUED COLLEAGUES, AND THE IRISH AND NORTHERN IRISH PEOPLE HAVE LOST GOOD FRIENDS.
3. THIS PAST MARCH, RON MET WITH A NUMBER OF VISITORS FROM BELFAST INCLUDING BARONESS DENTON, GERRY ADAMS, AND DAVID TRIMBLE. HE TOLD THEM ALL THAT COMMERCE WOULD CONTINUE ITS EFFORTS TO PROMOTE PEACE THROUGH COMMERCIAL DI-&} THAT OUR PLANS AND PROGRAMS WOULD REMAIN UNDAUNTED BY THE BREAKING OF THE CEASEFIRE. TO THIS END, I ASKED STU EIZENSTAT TO VISIT DUBLIN TO DEMONSTRATE VISIBLY OUR CONTINUED SUPPORT OF THE PEACE PROCESS. I LOOK FORWARD TO HIS REPORTS UPON HIS RETURN.
4. WE ARE ALSO CONTINUING THE EFFORTS OF CHUCK MEISSNER WITH PLANNING FOR THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGIES BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT MISSION THAT WILL VISIT NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE

BORDER COUNTIES JUNE 10-13.

5. YOU WILL BE HAPPY TO KNOW THAT, TO DATE, 13 U.S. FIRMS HAVE COMMITTED TO TAKE PART IN THE MISSION. WE ARE ELATED BY THE ENTHUSIASTIC RESPONSE TO OUR EFFORTS BY THE U.S. BUSINESS COMMUNITY AND THEIR INTEREST IN PURSUING COMMERCIAL OPPORTUNITIES IN THE REGION. COMMERCE WILL BE WORKING CLOSELY WITH ED CANNON, OUR SENIOR FOREIGN COMMERCIAL OFFICER IN DUBLIN, AND HIS TALENTED COMMERCIAL SPECIALISTS, WHOSE HARD WORK AND EXPERTISE CONTRIBUTED TO THE SUCCESS OF EARLIER, COLLABORATIVE EVENTS SUCH AS THE WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE LAST MAY AND THE INITIAL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT MISSION THAT CHUCK LED LAST OCTOBER. WE ARE VERY GRATEFUL FOR YOUR GENEROUS SUPPORT FOR THESE PROGRAMS.

6. WE ARE ALSO LOOKING AT ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PLANNING OF A COMMERCE CONFERENCE FOR TRADE AND INVESTMENT IN NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE BORDER COUNTIES, INCLUDING THE DATES, CONSULTING WITH MAYOR RENDELL.

7. THANK YOU FOR YOUR INVITATION TO VISIT DUBLIN, AND FOR SUGGESTING EVENTS TO WHICH SUCH A VISIT COULD BE TIED. YOUR OFFER IS APPEALING AND I HOPE TO VISIT DUBLIN SOON. I WILL KEEP YOU UPDATED AS MY PLANS PROCEED. THANK YOU AGAIN FOR YOUR KIND MESSAGE. BEST REGARDS, I LOOK FORWARD TO WORKING WITH YOU IN THESE IMPORTANT EFFORTS. MICKEY.

1. HMG MINISTER MICHAEL ANCRAM MET A SINN FEIN DELEGATION LED BY MARTIN MCGUINNESS AT STORMONT FOR THE SECOND TIME ON MAY 24. AFTER A MEETING LASTING TWO HOURS, MCGUINNESS ACCUSED HMG OF HAVING A "HESITANT APPROACH" TO THE PEACE PROCESS.
2. AMONG THE TOPICS DISCUSSED WAS THE ISSUE OF MISSING BODIES - PEOPLE BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN KILLED BY THE IRA WHO HAVE NEVER BEEN ACCOUNTED FOR, AND WHOSE FAMILIES ARE SEEKING TO FIND OUT WHAT HAPPENED TO THEM (REFTEL). ANCRAM REPORTEDLY URGED SINN FEIN TO PUT PRESSURE ON THE IRA TO DISCLOSE THE WHEREABOUTS OF THE BODIES. ANCRAM ALSO STRESSED HMG'S POSITION THAT THERE WOULD BE NO SUBSTANTIVE DIALOGUE WITH SINN FEIN UNTIL PROGRESS WAS MADE ON THE DECOMMISSIONING OF ARMS. MCGUINNESS INSISTED THAT SINN FEIN HAD TO BE INVOLVED IN ALL PARTY TALKS AND CALLED ON HMG AND THE IRISH GOVERNMENT TO "MOVE QUICKLY" TO SUCH DIALOGUE.
3. ANCRAM ALSO DISCLOSED THAT HMG FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WOULD NO LONGER BE WITHHELD FROM THE CONWAY MILL IN WEST BELFAST. HE SAID THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE HAD MADE THE DECISION "IN LIGHT OF THE CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES AND CONTINUING DEVELOPMENTS SINCE THE CESSATION DECLARATION." MCGUINNESS WELCOMED THE LIFTING OF THE BAN ON FUNDING, DESCRIBING IT AS "ONE OF THE MOST BLATANT EXAMPLES OF DISCRIMINATION AGAINST THE

PEOPLE OF WEST BELFAST..."

1. GIVEN THE IMPORTANCE OF EUROPEAN SECURITY/DEFENSE ISSUES IN OUR PUBLIC AFFAIRS STRATEGY (REFTELS A-D), APPROPRIATE HIGH-LEVEL VISITS BY SENIOR U.S. GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS WOULD MAKE A SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION TO THE EMBASSY'S PROGRAM FOR ENGAGING OUR IRISH INTERLOCUTORS (REFTELS E-F). SINCE IRELAND IS NOT A MEMBER OF NATO, IT FOCUSSES ON THESE ISSUES THROUGH THE PRISMS OF THE EU AND THE OSCE. THIS SITUATION IS UNLIKELY TO CHANGE UNTIL AFTER THE 1996 INTER-GOVERNMENTAL CONFERENCE AND MAY NOT EVEN THEN. THUS, VISITS BY U.S. OFFICIALS FROM USDEL OSCE AND THE DEPARTMENT WOULD BE MOST WELCOME. IN PARTICULAR, IF CRAIG DUNKERLEY COULD PASS THIS WAY ON HIS RETURN TO WASHINGTON, HE COULD ENGAGE OUR IRISH INTERLOCUTORS ON A VARIETY OF EUROPEAN SECURITY ISSUES UNDER THE AEGIS OF THE OSCE. EARLIER THIS YEAR, THE IRISH GOVERNMENT HELD A NUMBER OF PUBLIC SEMINARS IN PREPARATION FOR THE PUBLICATION THIS SUMMER OF A "WHITE PAPER" ON FOREIGN POLICY. UNFORTUNATELY, THIS EXERCISE IN THE ATTEMPTED EDUCATION OF PUBLIC OPINION WAS LESS SUCCESSFUL THAN HAD BEEN HOPED, AS SUGGESTED BY IRISH RELUCTANCE TO JOIN THE

PARTNERSHIP FOR PEACE. A VISIT BY A U.S. EXPERT ON EUROPEAN SECURITY ISSUES WOULD BE A VALUABLE SUPPLEMENT TO IRISH GOVERNMENT EFFORTS IN THIS REGARD. THE EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS OF MR. DUNKERLEY'S VISIT WOULD SIGNIFICANTLY ASSIST THE EMBASSY IN ITS ATTEMPTS TO ENCOURAGE THE IRISH GOVERNMENT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE BUILDING OF NEW EUROPEAN SECURITY ARCHITECTURE.

2. DEPENDING ON THE TIME AVAILABLE, THE EMBASSY COULD PROGRAM MR. DUNKERLEY IN A VARIETY OF VENUES, INCLUDING THE DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, THE INSTITUTE OF EUROPEAN AFFAIRS (DUBLIN'S ONLY FOREIGN POLICY "THINK-TANK") AND TRINITY COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY COLLEGE DUBLIN. HE COULD ALSO ADDRESS LOCAL WORTHIES AT THE AMBASSADOR'S RESIDENCE, DO AN IN-DEPTH INTERVIEW WITH THE "IRISH TIMES," AND APPEAR ON RADIO/TV. AFTER LEARNING HOW MUCH TIME MR. DUNKERLEY COULD SPEND HERE, WE WOULD DRAW UP A DETAILED PROGRAM.

3. PLEASE ADVISE WHETHER MR. DUNKERLEY OR OTHER OFFICIALS MAY BE AVAILABLE TO VISIT DUBLIN EITHER PRIOR TO THE SUMMER BREAK HERE, WHICH BEGINS IN MID-JULY AND ENDS IN THE LAST WEEK OF AUGUST. THANKS IN ADVANCE FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE.

IN REMARKS BEFORE THE LONDON CONSULAR CORPS, THE NORTHERN IRELAND JUNIOR MINISTER STRONGLY AFFIRMED THE BRITISH STANCE THAT THERE WILL BE NO MOVEMENT TOWARD ALL-PARTY TALKS WITHOUT MOVEMENT ON DECOMMISSIONING OF ARMS BY THE PARAMILITARIES. HE ALSO INDICATED THAT THERE WOULD BE NO SPECIAL TREATMENT OF PARAMILITARY PRISONERS, WHO HAVE ALL BEEN TRIED AND CONVICTED ON CRIMINAL CHARGES. END SUMMARY.

2. SPEAKING TO THE LONDON CONSULAR CORPS AT A JUNE 23 LUNCHEON MEETING, SIR JOHN WHEELER, JUNIOR MINISTER FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, REITERATED THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S POSITION THAT THERE COULD BE NO PROGRESS TO ALL-PARTY TALKS ON NORTHERN IRELAND UNTIL THE IRA MOVES ON DECOMMISSIONING ITS ARMS. HE GAVE A GENERAL INVENTORY OF THE KINDS OF OFFENSIVE WEAPONS THE IRA RETAINS, STOCKPILED PRIMARILY IN THE REPUBLIC, HE NOTED, WHICH ENDED WITH THE CLAIM THAT THE GROUP HAS ENOUGH SEMTEX TO CREATE "100 OKLAHAMAS," MEANING OKLAHOMA CITY. WHEELER SAID THE GOVERNMENT HAD TO BE COGNIZANT OF THE VIEWS OF THE MAJORITY IN NORTHERN IRELAND AND THAT OTHER (PROTESTANT) POLITICAL PARTIES SIMPLY WOULD NOT SIT DOWN TO NEGOTIATIONS WITH PROVISIONAL SINN FEIN WITH THE THREAT OF RESUMED VIOLENCE FROM A STILL-ARMED IRA HANGING OVER THEIR HEADS.

3. CONTRASTING THE LACK OF MOVEMENT BY THE IRA, WHEELER ITEMIZED HMG'S MOVES TO NORMALIZE THE SITUATION IN NORTHERN IRELAND: ALL ROADS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC AND THE NORTH HAD BEEN REOPENED, VIRTUALLY ALL BRIDGES HAD BEEN RESTORED AND TROOPS HAD BEEN REMOVED FROM THE STREETS. HE STRESSED THAT THE MOVES TO DATE WERE REVERSIBLE BUT WOULD BE FOLLOWED BY IRREVERSIBLE CHANGES ONCE THE IRA HAD COMMITTED ITSELF IRREVERSIBLY TO PEACE. HE WENT ON TO EXTOL THE VIRTUES OF THE PEACE PROCESS AND IT'S BENEFITS TO THE PEOPLE ON BOTH SIDES OF THE BORDER, NOTING THAT THE FAVORITE SHOPPING CITY FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE REPUBLIC WAS NOW BELFAST, WHERE BUSLOADS OF SHOPPERS FROM THE SOUTH NOW ARRIVE TO SHOP FOR LESS EXPENSIVE GOODS THAN THOSE AVAILABLE IN THE REPUBLIC.

4. WHEELER NOTED THAT HMG'S VIEW WAS THAT THERE WERE NO POLITICAL PRISONERS IN NORTHERN IRELAND, THAT ALL FROM BOTH LOYALIST AND REPUBLICAN SIDES HAD BEEN CONVICTED OF COMMON AND OFTEN HEINOUS CRIMES AND WOULD NOT BE TREATED DIFFERENTLY FROM COMMON CRIMINALS. IN RESPONSE TO A QUESTION, HE SAID HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE DIPLOCK COURTS ABOLISHED BUT UNTIL THE PROBLEMS OF INTIMIDATION OF WITNESSES AND JURORS ARE COMPLETELY ERADICATED, THEY WOULD REMAIN.

5. STRESSING THAT GERRY ADAMS "IS NO NELSON MANDELA," THAT PROVISIONAL SINN FEIN AND THE PROVISIONAL IRA ARE ONE AND THE SAME AND THAT SINN FEIN ONLY RECEIVES ONE AND A HALF PERCENT OF THE VOTE IN THE REPUBLIC AND 10 PERCENT IN THE NORTH, WHEELER SAID SINN FEIN WOULD HAVE A PLACE AT THE NEGOTIATING TABLE BUT NOT ONE EARNED BY THE THREAT OF RESUMED VIOLENCE. IN CLOSING, WHEELER ASKED THE DIPLOMATS PRESENT TO TAKE BACK THE MESSAGE THAT HMG NEEDED THEIR SUPPORT FOR ITS EFFORTS TO TAKE THE PEACE PROCESS FORWARD.

6. COMMENT: IN A DISCUSSION WITH THE ACTING CONSUL GENERAL PRIOR TO WHEELER'S LUNCHEON REMARKS, A CONSULAR OFFICER FROM THE IRISH EMBASSY REMARKED THAT BOTH SINN FEIN AND THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT WERE BEING INTRANSIGENT ON THE DECOMMISSIONING ISSUE. IN RESPONSE TO THE COMMENT THAT THE UNIONISTS SEEMED UNLIKELY TO SIT DOWN WITH SINN FEIN WHILE DECOMMISSIONING WAS UNRESOLVED, THE IRISH DIPLOMAT SAID HE FELT THE UNIONISTS WERE IRRELEVANT TO THE ISSUE. END COMMENT. CROWE

1. SENATOR MITCHELL, IN ANTICIPATION OF YOUR VISIT NEXT WEEK, WE HAVE PUT TOGETHER SOME INITIAL IDEAS FOR A FOLLOW-UP PROGRAM TO THE WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE. IN PARALLEL WITH THE COMPANY-LEVEL MATCHMAKING SESSIONS, WE SHOULD MOVE QUICKLY TO SET UP SECTORAL TRADE MISSIONS IN FOUR SECTORS IN IRELAND OFFERING NEAR-TERM PROSPECTS FOR PROMOTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT -- TOURISM, AGRO-INDUSTRY/FOOD PROCESSING, INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, AND THE ENVIRONMENT. THREE OF THESE SECTORS ARE ALSO GERMANE FOR DOC'S ONGOING SHOWCASE EUROPE PROJECT AND THUS WOULD REINFORCE IT. A) TOURISM: THIS MISSION SHOULD INCLUDE A BROAD RANGE OF FIRMS AND INDUSTRY ORGANIZATIONS FROM THE TOURISM, HOSPITALITY, AND ENTERTAINMENT SECTORS: LODGING, FOOD SERVICE, THE TRAVEL INDUSTRY (AGENCIES, CRUISE LINES, AIR CHARTERS, DEVELOPERS, ETC.). C) INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY/TELECOMMUNICATIONS - EMBASSY RECOMMENDS A MISSION INCLUDING BOTH PROVIDERS AND CONSUMERS OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY. THE FORMER WOULD LOOK AT INVESTMENT AND JOINT VENTURE OPPORTUNITIES WHILE THE LATTER WOULD BE INTRODUCED TO THE DIVERSE RANGE OF SERVICES AVAILABLE TO SUPPORT THEIR OPERATIONS. U.S. FIRMS WITH EUROPEAN OPERATIONS MAY FIND THIS ASPECT OF THE MISSION PARTICULARLY PROMISING. WE SUGGEST THIS MISSION MEET IN THE DUNDALK-NEWRY AREA OF "THE DUBLIN-BELFAST ECONOMIC CORRIDOR."

D) ENVIRONMENT - EU ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATIONS HAVE CREATED OPPORTUNITIES IN EUROPE FOR BUILDERS/PROVIDERS OF "GREEN" TECHNOLOGY AND SERVICES. IRELAND AND NORTHERN IRELAND OFFER BOTH A MARKET AND AN EU BASE FOR SUCH FIRMS. ALSO, U.S., IRISH, AND UK INTERNATIONAL TRADE ASSOCIATIONS AND RELEVANT UNCLAS SECTION 03 OF 03 DUBLIN 003044

11. FREQUENT TRADE AND INVESTMENT MISSIONS SPONSORED BY THE PRIVATE SECTOR AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS VISIT THE ISLAND. EMBASSY DUBLIN AND CONGEN BELFAST COOPERATE IN PROVIDING SUBSTANTIAL ASSISTANCE TO THESE GROUPS. AS A MATTER OF ONGOING POLICY, EMBASSY DUBLIN WILL WORK WITH THESE GROUPS TO TARGET THEM IN REGIONS AND SECTORS WHICH ARE IMPORTANT FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE PEACE PROCESS. LIKewise, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATIONS IN THE NORTH AND BORDER COUNTIES ARE KEEN TO PROMOTE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT AND EMBASSY DUBLIN AND CONGEN BELFAST WILL CONTINUE TO WORK WITH THEM TO IMPROVE THEIR ACCESS TO INVESTORS AND DEVELOPMENT AGENCIES. SOME SPECIFIC EXAMPLES OF THESE ARE:

-- IRISH CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IN THE USA (ICUSA): 40-PERSON VISIT PLANNED TO IRELAND AND NORTHERN IRELAND THE WEEK OF JUNE 26;

-- CONFEDERATION OF AMERICAN STATES IN EUROPE (CASE): IS PLANNING A TRADE DAY IN DUBLIN IN SEPTEMBER. EMBASSY WILL PROMOTE BROAD ATTENDANCE FROM THROUGHOUT IRELAND AND WILL ENCOURAGE CASE TO PLAN A LARGER TRADE AND INVESTMENT MISSION;

-- REFTEL REPORTS ON FOUR COMMUNITY-BASED PROGRAMS WHICH EMBASSY BELIEVES MERIT USG SUPPORT: 1) A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY BANKING; 2) A MENTOR PROGRAM FOR SMALL BUSINESSES AND START-UP FIRMS ; 3) COMMUNITY-DESIGNATED DEVELOPMENT AREAS IN THE CITY OF BELFAST; AND 4) DEVELOPMENT OF CROSS-COUNTY DEVELOPMENT PLANS. THE LEAD IN ALL THESE AREAS MUST LIE WITH LOCAL OFFICIALS AND GROUPS. NONETHELESS, THE USG SHOULD, IF REQUESTED, PROVIDE APPROPRIATE TECHNICAL OR POLITICAL SUPPORT. FOR EXAMPLE, A MENTOR PROGRAM (A SORT OF AMSIT IN REVERSE) OR COMMUNITY BANKING PROGRAM COULD BE PURSUED WITH IFI. USG OR U.S. NGO DEVELOPMENT SPECIALISTS COULD PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO COMMUNITY GROUPS IN IDENTIFYING DEVELOPMENT AREAS OR CRAFTING DEVELOPMENT PLANS.
