The materials in FOIA 2010-0452-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

This collection contains material regarding the pardon of Kemba Smith. In 1994, Smith was sentenced to 24.5 years in federal prison for activites as a first time non-violent drug offender. Smith's case exemplified the enforcement of mandatory sentencing laws for minor drug convictions. President Clinton granted her clemency on December 22, 2000. This collection primarily contains correspondence and media publications in support of Smith's release.
