REQUEST: Drop-bys on my meetings with Northern Ireland party leaders Gerry Adams (Sinn Fein), John Hume (SDLP) and David Trimble (UUP).

PURPOSE: To give another push to the Northern Ireland peace process.

BACKGROUND: The British Government's proposal to move all-party talks by holding an election has elicited vehement opposition from the nationalist side. At the same time, the unionists are still clinging to weapons decommissioning as a precondition for moving forward. A brief meeting with the President will remind the leaders of the message of POTUS trip and give them political cover to reach a compromise. To show his balanced approach, the President should see all three leaders when they come here in the next two weeks.

PREVIOUS PARTICIPATION: The President saw Adams, Hume and Trimble November 30 in Belfast.

DATE AND TIME: February 1 for Adams; February 12-13 for Trimble; Hume still open.
