Purpose

To respond to Congressman Fish's letter on Northern Ireland.

Background

Congressman Fish wrote you a letter urging you to take a more active U.S. role in helping to bring the tragedy in Northern Ireland to an end. (The letter was co-signed by 32 members of the House.) In your response you refer to your meetings with British Prime Minister Major and Irish Prime Minister Reynolds, and reiterate that you will do all you can to contribute to a settlement.
