Scope and Content

FOIA 2019-0582-F is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs pertaining to luncheons and dinners at the White House. The events include a dinner for African-American Clergy on February 1, 1995, the Greece State Dinner on May 9, 1996, the Arts & Humanities Awards dinner on September 29, 1997, the British State Dinner on February 5, 1998, the Italian State Dinner on May 6, 1998, the Argentinian State Dinner on January 11, 1999, and a luncheon for Nordic leaders on April 28, 2000.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host a dinner and discussion with members of the African-American clergy at the White House. Present are Walter Fauntroy, Andrew Young, among others. The initial discussion takes place in the Blue Room, before the participants proceed to the State Dining Room for dinner.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
