Dear Mr. President:

I was very pleased to learn that Attorney General Reno suspended the removal proceedings of Noel Gaynor and five other Irish nationals whom had been under the threat of deportation for past association with the Irish Republican Army. Thank you for this action, for I know it would not taken place without your approval.

I have gotten to know Mr. Gaynor during the last six months while I have been working to help him fight the deportation action and stay in New Jersey. He is a very good man, so I'm delighted that he and his family will continue to be my constituents.

I applaud your initiative and persistence in pursuing the peace process in Northern Ireland. The progress that has been made as a result of your leadership is remarkable. This gesture by our government will provide further encouragement to the Northern Ireland peace talks being chaired by Senator Mitchell in Belfast. I am hopeful that these talks will finally yield a solution to the terrible troubles that have plagued Ireland for so long.
