1. AN RUC INVESTIGATION TEAM HAS GIVEN THE ALL-CLEAR TO A ROOM AT STORMONT ALLOCATED TO SINN FEIN MEMBERS INVOLVED IN DISCUSSIONS WITH BRITISH OFFICIALS, AFTER ALLEGATIONS THAT THE ROOM HAD BEEN BUGGED. SINN FEIN CLAIMED ONE OF THEIR STAFF, USING MONITORING EQUIPMENT, HAD DISCOVERED A LISTENING DEVICE. TALKS WITH BRITISH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS WERE SUSPENDED WHILE THE INVESTIGATION WAS CARRIED OUT. AN RUC SPOKESMAN SAID NO LISTENING DEVICE WAS FOUND AND SUGGESTED THE MONITORING EQUIPMENT USED BE EXAMINED FOR FAULTS. A NORTHERN IRELAND OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID ANY SUGGESTION THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT MONITORED SINN FEIN ROOMS AT STORMONT WAS WITHOUT FOUNDATION. TALKS BETWEEN SINN FEIN AND GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ARE EXPECTED TO RESUME SHORTLY.

1. SINN FEIN HAS INDICATED THAT IT WILL RESUME ITS MEETINGS WITH HMG OFFICIALS SHORTLY, PROBABLY AROUND MARCH 9 OR 10. THE TWO SIDES HAVE NOT MET SINCE FEBRUARY 9, WHEN SINN FEIN WALKED OUT OF DISCUSSIONS, ALLEGING THAT THE DISCUSSION ROOM AT STORMONT HAD BEEN BUGGED. AN INVESTIGATION BY THE ROYAL ULSTER CONSTABULARY (RUC) INDICATED THAT THERE WERE NO BUGS, AND THAT THE SIGNAL HAD COME FROM A PHOTOCOPYING MACHINE. SINN FEIN SAID IT HAD NO CONFIDENCE IN THE INVESTIGATION, BUT THE ENTIRE AFFAIR SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN PUT ASIDE.

2. THE MEETING IS EXPECTED TO CONCENTRATE ON THE ISSUE OF PRISONERS. SINN FEIN PRESIDENT GERRY ADAMS CALLED FOR "SPEEDY MOVEMENT ON THE RELEASE OF ALL POLITICAL PRISONERS," WHETHER IN IRELAND, BRITAIN, EUROPE OR THE USA, AT THE PARTY'S ARDFEIS (CONFERENCE) LAST WEEK.

ON FEBRUARY 22, 1995, THE PRESIDENCY, ON BEHALF OF THE EUROPEAN UNION, MADE THE FOLLOWING DECLARATION ON THE PUBLICATION OF THE ANGLO-IRISH FRAMEWORK DOCUMENT ON NORTHERN IRELAND.

BEGIN TEXT OF DECLARATION:

THE EUROPEAN UNION WELCOMES THE PUBLICATION OF THE ANGLO-IRISH FRAMEWORK DOCUMENT, WHICH LAYS THE FOUNDATIONS FOR NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE VARIOUS PARTIES INVOLVED IN THE NORTHERN IRELAND ISSUE.

THE DRAWING UP OF THAT DOCUMENT MARKS A SIGNIFICANT STEP IN THE PEACE PROCESS AND CONFIRMS THE MOVEMENT INITIATED BY THE ANGLO-IRISH DECLARATION IN DECEMBER 1993.

THE EUROPEAN UNION WISHES AT THIS TIME TO REAFFIRM ITS FULL SUPPORT FOR THE EFFORTS BEING MADE BY THE UNITED KINGDOM AND IRISH GOVERNMENTS FOR PEACE AND RECONCILIATION IN NORTHERN IRELAND. IT POINTS TO THE COMMUNITY AID PROGRAMME RECENTLY AGREED ON IN PRINCIPLE TO PROMOTE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN NORTHERN IRELAND AND IN THE BORDERING COUNTIES IN THE SOUTH AND WELCOMES THE EFFORTS UNDERTAKEN IN THIS WAY TO ASSIST THE PEACE PROCESS.

SUBJECT: LOYALISTS COMPLAIN OF BEING "FORGOTTEN" IN THE PEACE
PROCESS

1. REPRESENTATIVES OF THE FRINGE LOYALIST PARTIES HAVE ACCUSED THE BRITISH, IRISH AND U.S. GOVERNMENTS OF UNFAIR TREATMENT IN THE PEACE PROCESS. AND, THEY WARNED THAT UNLESS THEY ARE GIVEN "PARITY OF ESTEEM" WITH REPUBLICANS, THEY WOULD FIND IT INCREASINGLY DIFFICULT TO KEEP EXTREME ELEMENTS OF THE LOYALIST COMMUNITY ON BOARD. CALLING FOR DIRECT TALKS WITH HMG MINISTERS IN THE NEAR FUTURE TO "PRESERVE THE PEACE PROCESS," PROGRESSIVE UNIONIST PARTY (PUP) SPOKESMAN, BILLY HUTCHINSON WARNED, "THIS IS NOT A VEILED THREAT...THIS IS REALITY..."

2. SPEAKING ON MARCH 13, AS HE WAS ABOUT TO BEGIN A SEVENTH ROUND OF TALKS WITH HMG OFFICIALS AT STORMONT, HUTCHINSON SPOKE OF THE INCREASING UNEASE FELT BY MANY IN THE LOYALIST COMMUNITY AT WHAT THEY SEE AS PANDERING TO THE REPUBLICAN MOVEMENT BY THE U.S. ADMINISTRATION AND THE NORTHERN IRELAND OFFICE. HUTCHINSON COMPLAINED THAT LOYALISTS WERE "FOLLOWING IN THE WAKE OF GERRY ADAMS EVERY STEP OF THE WAY AND WE DON'T LIKE IT." HUTCHINSON NOTED, "WE ARE BEING TREATED LIKE BIT PLAYERS AND WE REFUSE TO BE TREATED LIKE THAT, AND WE'RE GOING TO START TAKING A HARD LINE POLITICALLY. ..OUR PEOPLE ARE SAYING TO US, WHAT HAVE YOU ACHIEVED. WE ARE NOT ACHIEVING ANYTHING. THE AMERICANS DID NOT INVITE US TO FUND RAISE." HUTCHINSON CALLED ON THE BRITISH PRIME MINISTER, JOHN MAJOR, TO MEET LOYALIST REPRESENTATIVES AS AN EQUIVALENT GESTURE TO PRESIDENT CLINTON MEETING SINN FEIN PRESIDENT GERRY ADAMS. "WE THINK THAT IF JOHN MAJOR CAN MEET YASSER ARAFAT, HE CAN MEET

US." ULSTER DEMOCRATIC PARTY (UDP) SPOKESMAN, GARY MCMICHAEL, COMPLAINED THAT "THE MAIN PROBLEM IS THAT GERRY ADAMS HAS BEEN ELEVATED BY THE U.S. GOVERNMENT IN QUESTIONABLE CIRCUMSTANCES."

3. AFTER THE MEETING, HOWEVER, POLITICAL DEVELOPMENT MINISTER, MICHAEL ANCRAM INDICATED THAT IT WAS TOO SOON FOR DIRECT MINISTERIAL TALKS. HE REPORTEDLY ALSO RULED OUT A LOYALIST MEETING WITH THE PRIME MINISTER.

4. IN A MARCH 14 CONVERSATION WITH GARY MCMICHAEL ON A SEPARATE ISSUE, THE CONSUL GENERAL REMINDED THE UDP LEADER THAT HE WAS NOT INELIGIBLE TO RAISE FUNDS IN THE UNITED STATES. FUNDRAISING BY LOYALIST LEADERS WHO WERE INELIGIBLE FOR VISAS WAS ANOTHER MATTER, THE CG NOTED, AND PERHAPS BEST DISCUSSED PRIVATELY AMONG THE CG AND THE UDP AND PUP.

SUBJECT: ULSTER UNIONIST M.P. JOHN TAYLOR IN GALWAY

1. ULSTER UNIONIST M.P. JOHN TAYLOR VISITED GALWAY ON MARCH 16 FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 25 YEARS TO ADDRESS THE ANNUAL DINNER OF THE GALWAY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY AS ITS GUEST OF HONOR. TAYLOR, WHO REPORTEDLY PLANS TO VISIT A NUMBER OF CITIES IN THE REPUBLIC IN THE NEAR FUTURE, WILL ADDRESS THE IRISH ASSOCIATION ON MARCH 27 AT DUBLIN'S MANSION HOUSE ON THE TOPIC "AFTER THE FRAMEWORK DOCUMENT: TRUST AND MISTRUST."

2. AT THE GALWAY DINNER, TAYLOR REPORTEDLY SAID THAT:

-- THERE SHOULD BE MORE NORTH-SOUTH LINKS FREE OF POLITICAL BAGGAGE AND UNDERPINNED BY THE REPUBLIC'S REJOINING STERLING.

-- PARITY EXISTED BETWEEN THE IRISH POUND AND STERLING, MAKING IT OPPORTUNE TO TURN THEM INTO A SINGLE CURRENCY, THEREBY OBTAINING OBSTACLES TO CROSS-BORDER TRADE.

-- "IN OUR JOINT MEMBERSHIP OF THE EUROPEAN UNION, THERE IS MORE REASON FOR INCREASED CROSS-BORDER TRADE, AND IT SHOULD HAVE NO POLITICAL BAGGAGE FOR EITHER PART OF THE ISLAND. IT SHOULD SOLELY BE FOR THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL ADVANCEMENT OF ALL OUR PEOPLE."

-- OBVIOUS OPPORTUNITIES EXIST FOR NORTHERN INVESTMENT IN THE REPUBLIC. FOR INSTANCE, NORTHERN IRELAND ELECTRICITY COULD TRANSMIT POWER TO BORDER COUNTIES IN THE REPUBLIC; BRITISH TELECOM COULD BECOME A MAJOR PARTNER OF TELECOM EIREANN; AND AER LINGUS COULD BECOME A SUBSIDIARY OF

BRITISH AIRWAYS.

-- THE TWO "SOVEREIGN ZATIONS" OF THE ISLAND OF IRELAND WERE "GENTLY" SEEKING A BETTER RELATIONSHIP GUARANTEEING PEACE AND A BETTER WAY OF LIFE.

-- NOTHING SADDENED HIM MORE THAN THE SPECTACLE OF EMIGRATION. "IN DUBLIN AND BELFAST, WE MUST DO MUCH MORE TO ENHANCE JOB OPPORTUNITIES AT HOME.

-- "THE FOUNDATION FOR THAT MUST BE COOPERATION AND MUTUAL RESPECT AND RECOGNITION BY EACH PART OF IRELAND FOR THE OTHER. PARITY OF ESTEEM MUST BE A TWO-WAY OBJECTIVE. AS WE WORK TO IMPROVE RELATIONS AND UNDERSTANDING, WE BOTH MUST ENDEAVOR TO RESIST THE TEMPTATION TO CRITICIZE AND, AT TIMES, INSULT.
