SUBJECT: AMBASSADOR MEETS WITH IRISH POLICE - GARDAI VIEW
ON CURRENT PIRA/SINN FEIN ACTIVITY.

1. ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 18, AMBASSADOR SMITH MET WITH REPUBLIC OF IRELAND POLICE (GARDA SIOCHANA) OFFICIALS TO DISCUSS PIRA TERRORIST/CRIMINAL ACTIVITY IN LIGHT OF THE CURRENT 12 WEEK OLD CEASE FIRE IN NORTHERN IRELAND. THE POLICE OFFICIALS WERE; ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER NOEL CONROY; CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT MICHAEL DIFFILY; DETECTIVE SUPERINTENDENT JOE EGAN; AND MR. PAUL HICKEY FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE.

2- THE FOLLOWING TOPICS WERE DISCUSSED:

- CURRENTLY, THE PEACE PROCESS IS HOLDING. PIRA/SINN FEIN ARE HOLDING TO THEIR COMMITMENT FOR PEACE AND THE PROSPECTS LOOK GOOD"
- THE PACE OF THE PEACE PROCESS IS CONTINUING WITH ALL SIDES ACTIVELY COMMUNICATING WITH EACH OTHER. HOWEVER THERE IS A SPLINTER GROUP, THE PROVISIONAL SINN FEIN, CONSISTING OF 50 TO 60 MEMBERS (AVERAGE AGE 50) WHO ARE OPPOSED TO ANY PEACE IN IRELAND. THE GARDA DO NOT CONSIDER THEM A REAL THREAT AT THIS TIME BUT TO INSURE PEACE, THIS GROUP IS CLOSELY BEING WATCHED.
- REPORTS OF HARASSMENT BY THE RUC ARE OVERBLOWN. EVERY TIME A RUC STOPS A PIRA MEMBER IN THE COURSE OF OFFICIAL POLICE DUTIES, THE POLICE ARE ACCUSED OF HARASSMENT. THE

POLICE ARE WATCHING PIRA MEMBERS CLOSELY AND PERFORMING THEIR JOBS AS POLICE OFFICERS, A JOB THAT HAS NOT BEEN DONE FOR YEARS DUE TO THE TERRORIST VIOLENCE. THE POLICE ARE CONTENT THAT PIRA AS AN ORGANIZATION, STILL EXISTS, SINCE THE LEADERSHIP FOR THE MOST PART IS ABLE TO CONTROL ITS MEMBERS. IF PIRA IS DISBANDED, LAW ENFORCEMENT/INTELLIGENCE WOULD LOSE CONTROL AND CONTACT WITH THESE MEMBERS AND BE OVERLY BURDENED WITH ADDITIONAL CRIMINAL ACTIVITY"

- GARDAI HAVE A REPUBLIC OF IRELAND PROGRAM WITH SINN FEIN TO DISCUSS REPORTS OF POLICE HARASSMENT- AN OPEN CHANNEL OF COMMUNICATION EXISTS.

- GARDAI BELIEVE THAT IF THE CURRENT PIRA/SINN FEIN STRUCTURE REMAINS INTACT, THERE WILL NOT BE A NOTICEABLE INCREASE IN CRIME. HOWEVER, IF THE ORGANIZATION DISBANDS, THERE MAY BE A SLIGHT INCREASE IN CRIMINAL ACTIVITY BY THE YOUNG, UNEMPLOYED MEMBERS OF PIRA. THIS TOPIC HAS TO BE REVIEWED IN THE CONTEXT OF ALL 26 COUNTIES AND WILL BE LOOKED AT MORE EXTENSIVELY AS THE PEACE PROCESS CONTINUES.

- THERE IS LITTLE INFORMATION ON THE TRANSPORT OF WEAPONS INTO THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND. CURRENT FINDINGS OF WEAPONS CACHES REVEAL THAT THEY ARE NOT BEING SERVICED. MANY WEAPONS HAVE BEEN FOUND RUSTED. IN ALL, ESTIMATES OF 1500 WEAPONS ARE CURRENTLY IN THE HANDS OF PIRA. THE POLICE POINTED OUT THAT WEAPONS CACHES HAVE BEEN FOUND WHICH DATE BACK TO THE 20'S. PEOPLE HAVE GONE TO THEIR GRAVES HAVING THE ONLY KNOWLEDGE OF THE LOCATIONS OF PIRA WEAPONS STORES- THIS WILL CONTINUE. THE POLICE BELIEVE THAT WEAPONS WILL NOT BE TURNED IN BECAUSE THERE ARE CURRENTLY OVER 600 WEAPONS THAT HAVE BEEN INVOLVED IN PAST CRIMINAL/TERRORIST ACTIVITY, BALLISTIC EVIDENCE RECOVERED FROM PAST CRIMINAL/TERRORIST INCIDENTS WILL SURELY BE USED TO IDENTIFY THESE WEAPONS IF THEY ARE TURNED IN AS PART OF A WEAPONS TRANSFER-

- THE POLICE FEEL THAT THE RETURN OF ARMS IS NOT ESSENTIAL TO THE PEACE PROCESS. IF ALL THE CURRENT ARMS ARE SURRENDERED, NEW WEAPONS COULD EASILY BE PROCURED, SO THEREFORE WHY IS IT MANDATORY THAT THE WEAPONS BE TURNED IN? IN THEIR VIEW, THIS QUESTION IS PART OF A WIDER AGENDA AND MUST BE ADDRESSED IN STAGES. IF THIS WEAPONS ISSUE IS A STICKING POINT, IT COULD HOLD UP THE WHOLE PEACE PROCESS.

- THE LOYALIST ALSO HAVE WEAPONS. THE USE OF THOSE WEAPONS WILL BE DICTATED BY THE ADHERENCE TO THE ORDERS OF THE CURRENT POWER STRUCTURE WITHIN THOSE GROUPS. DISCIPLINE WILL DICTATE THE THREAT. THE POLICE VIEW THAT THE LOYALIST THREAT TO THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND IS LIMITED.

OFFICIALS

1. A FIVE-STRONG SINN FEIN DELEGATION MET WITH BRITISH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AT STORMONT PARLIAMENT BUILDING ON DECEMBER 9. THE DELGATES, LED BY DERRY REPUBLICAN MARTIN MCGUINNESS, ALSO INCLUDED SLIGO COUNCILLOR SEAN MCMANUS, PARTY GENERAL SECRETARY LUCILITA BREATHNACH, SIOBHAN OHANLON, AND GERRY KELLY. (THE LATTER WAS JAILED FOR LIFE FOR A 1973 IRA BOMBING IN ENGLAND.) ON HIS WAY INTO THE BUILDING, MARTIN MCGUINNESS SPOKE BRIEFLY TO REPORTERS AND SAID THAT SINN FEIN WOULD APPROACH THE TALKS IN A "POSITIVE AND CONSTRUCTIVE" FASHION. THERE WAS NO OFFICIAL GREETING FOR THE DELEGATION; THEY REPORTEDLY WALKED THROUGH A SIDE DOOR TO PARLIAMENT BUILDINGS WHERE THE MEETING WAS TO TAKE PLACE.

2. SINN FEIN SUBMITTED SIX DEMANDS IN A FIVE PAGE DOCUMENT READ OUT TO HMG OFFICIALS AT THE TALKS. THE DOCUMENT CALLED FOR AN END TO BRITISH MILITARY OPERATIONS; SPEEDY RELEASE OF ALL POLITICAL PRISONERS; A SETTLEMENT BASED ON THE FUNDAMENTAL RIGHT OF THE IRISH PEOPLE TO SELF-DETERMINATION; TREATMENT OF SINN FEIN THE SAME AS ALL OTHER PARTIES; RECOGNITION OF THE MANDATE OF SINN FEIN VOTERS, AND SPEEDY MOVEMENT TO INCLUSIVE TALKS. THE DOCUMENT ALSO OUTLINED SINN FEINS AIM OF A UNITED IRELAND AND ITS DETERMINATION TO BE CONSTRUCTIVE AND RESPONSIBLE. IN ADDITION, IT ADDRESSED UNIONIST CONCERNS: "THIS PROCESS OF NATIONAL RECONCILIATION MUST SECURE THE POLITICAL, RELIGIOUS AND DEMOCRATIC RIGHTS OF A NORTHERN UNIONIST POPULATION."

3. A MEMBER OF THE DEMOCRATIC UNIONIST PARTY, CEDRIC WILSON, WAS DRAGGED SCREAMING AWAY FROM STORMONT AFTER HE HANDED IN A LETTER OF PROTEST, SHORTLY BEFORE THE SINN FEIN DELEGATION ARRIVED. AS HE WAS BEING REMOVED BY POLICE, HE SHOUTED THAT SINN FEIN MEMBERS SHOULD BE ARRESTED AND IMPRISONED RATHER THAN INVITED TO TALK TO THE GOVERNMENT. HIS PARTY LEADER, REV. IAN PAISLEY, DESCRIBED THE MEETING AS "ONE OF THE DARKEST DAYS IN THE HISTORY OF THE UNION." HE CLAIMED THAT THE TALKS WITH SINN FEIN ARE REALLY TALKS WITH THE IRA, AND THAT THEY WERE PART OF HMGS "SURRENDER" POLICY. PAISLEY ACCUSED HMG OF BOWING TO ANY PRESSURE SINN FEIN EXERTS. PAISLEY AVERRED, "AS THEY HAD NOT THE COURAGE TO DEFEAT THE IRA, THEY CAN HARDLY BE EXPECTED TO HAVE THE COURAGE TO STAND UP TO THEM POLITICALLY."

SURPRISE AT PROGRESS SINCE THE SIGNING OF THE DOWNING STREET
DECLARATION

1. SPEAKING IN BELFAST AFTER THE INVESTMENT CONFERENCE ON DECEMBER 14, BRITISH PRIME MINISTER JOHN MAJOR SPOKE OF THE NEED FOR THE IRA TO DESTROY OR HAND IN ITS WEAPONS BEFORE ANY FULL NEGOTIATIONS COULD TAKE PLACE WITH SINN FEIN. MAJOR SAID THE WEAPONS ISSUE WAS CENTRAL TO WHETHER SINN FEIN COULD ENTER MAINSTREAM POLITICS, BECAUSE, IF IT WAS NOT RESOLVED, THE OTHER POLITICAL PARTIES IN NORTHERN IRELAND, THE LOYALIST PARAMILITARIES, OR THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT COULD NOT SIT DOWN WITH THEM. HE WELCOMED SINN FEIN'S ASSERTION THAT IT WISHED TO BECOME FULLY INVOLVED IN DEMOCRATIC POLITICS, BUT POINTED OUT THAT, "IF THAT IS SO THEY WILL NOT NEED LARGE STOCKS OF WEAPONS THAT THEY MAY THEN REVERT TO IF ONE DEMOCRATIC DECISION OR ANOTHER GOES AGAINST THEM." MAJOR SAID HE WAS NOT CONCERNED HOW THE WEAPONS WERE DISCARDED - WHETHER DECOMMISSIONED OR DESTROYED, AS LONG AS THEY WERE "...NO LONGER AVAILABLE FOR USE IN TERRORIST ATTACKS IN NORTHERN IRELAND." IN ADDITION, THE PRIME MINISTER NOTED, THE EXPLORATORY DIALOGUE BETWEEN SINN FEIN AND GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES MUST BE SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED BEFORE HE WOULD SIT DOWN WITH SINN FEIN PRESIDENT GERRY ADAMS.

2. THE PRIME MINISTER SAID THAT HE HAD BEEN SURPRISED BY THE PROGRESS MADE SINCE THE SIGNING OF THE DOWNING STREET

DECLARATION ON DECEMBER 15, 1993. NORTHERN IRELAND, HE SAID, HAD TRAVELLED FURTHER DOWN THE ROAD TO PEACE THAN MANY PEOPLE COULD HAVE IMAGINED. "FRANKLY, FURTHER THAN I HAD IMAGINED WE WOULD GET IN THIS SHORT TIMESCALE.." HE SAID HE HAD BEEN WARNED BY THE "WORDLYWISE" THAT HE WOULD BE FOOLISH TO RISK BEING BROUGHT TO GRIEF BY THE IRISH QUESTION, AS HAD BEFALLEN MANY OF HIS PREDECESSORS BUT, HE SAID, A SITUATION IN WHICH TERRORISM CONTINUED AND PEOPLE WERE DYING WAS INTOLERABLE TO HIM. MAJOR SAID HE DECIDED IT MUST BE ONE OF HIS PRIORITIES AND THAT IT WOULD REMAIN SO. NOTHING, HE PROMISED, WOULD BE IMPOSED UPON THE PEOPLE OF NORTHERN IRELAND AGAINST THEIR WILL. "NOTHING IS GOING TO BE ACHIEVED, LET US NOT FOOL OURSELVES, IF IT FLIES IN THE FACE OF OPINION IN ULSTER, IT SIMPLY WONT STICK."

1. SPOKESMEN FROM REPUBLICAN AND LOYALIST COMMUNITIES HAVE EXPRESSED THEIR DISMAY AT THE GOVERNMENT'S DECISION TO GRANT CHRISTMAS PAROLE TO FEWER THAN 100 TERRORIST PRISONERS. A GOVERNMENT STATEMENT OF DECEMBER 22 ANNOUNCED THAT SOME 350 PRISONERS OVERALL WOULD BE RELEASED FOR A SEVEN-DAY PERIOD. HOWEVER, A BREAKDOWN OF THE FIGURES SHOWED THAT 47 OF THOSE ARE REPUBLICAN PRISONERS, AND 46 ARE LOYALIST. THE REST ARE, IN THE WORDS OF SINN FEIN PRISON SPOKESMAN PAT MCGEOWN, "NON-POLITICAL." MCGEOWN SAID THAT HMG HAD "DELIBERATELY CREATED THE MISCONCEPTION" THAT HUNDREDS OF REPUBLICANS AND LOYALISTS WOULD BE GRANTED PAROLE. HE SAID, "SOMEONE NEEDS TO TELL THE NIO THAT NOW IS A TIME OF GOODWILL AND GENEROSITY AND NOT FOR DUPLICITY AND DECEIT." JOHN WHITE, ULSTER DEMOCRATIC PARTY SPOKESMAN FOR PRISONERS SAID LOYALISTS WERE ALSO DISAPPOINTED. HE CALLED ON THE GOVERNMENT TO CHANGE THE CRITERIA USED TO DETERMINE WHETHER A PRISONER IS ELIGIBLE FOR PAROLE. AT THE MOMENT, A PRISONER MUST HAVE SERVED 11 YEARS OF A SENTENCE BEFORE HE/SHE QUALIFIES FOR PAROLE. WHITE CALLED FOR THE SENTENCE SERVED TO BE DROPPED TO 10 YEARS. HE CRITICIZED THE GOVERNMENT FOR NOT RESPONDING TO THE CEASEFIRES WITH THE "IMAGINATION AND GENEROSITY THEY PROMISED."

2. CATHOLIC PRIMATE CARDINAL CAHAL DALY WELCOMED THE PAROLE AND SAID IT WAS "WISE AND TIMELY." HOWEVER, HE URGED THE GOVERNMENT TO GO FURTHER, SAYING THAT A PERMANENT RELEASE, PHASED IN OVER A PERIOD, WOULD BE A POSITIVE CONTRIBUTION TO THE PEACE PROCESS.

3. SECRETARY OF STATE, SIR PATRICK MAYHEW, HOWEVER, QUASHED ANY HOPE THAT EARLY RELEASE WAS A POSSIBILITY. IN AN INTERVIEW PUBLISHED BY THE "IRISH NEWS" ON DECEMBER 23, HE SAID, "I CAN GUARANTEE THAT THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN SENTENCED BY THE COURTS WILL SERVE THEIR SENTENCES ACCORDING TO THE LAW... THERE ARE NO POLITICAL PRISONERS..ANYWHERE IN THIS COUNTRY. ANYONE WHO IS IN PRISON HERE IN NORTHERN IRELAND IS IN PRISON BECAUSE THEY HAVE BEEN CONVICTED OF CRIMINAL OFFENCES BY INDEPENDENT COURTS." THE SECRETARY OF STATE ALSO ADDRESSED THE ISSUE OF CHRISTMAS PAROLE, SAYING THAT THE NUMBERS WERE DOWN ON LAST YEAR BECAUSE NOT AS MANY PRISONERS WERE ELIGIBLE FOR IT THIS YEAR.

1. POST REQUESTS AN INCREASE OF DOLS 5,000 IN ITS FIRST QUARTER REPRESENTATIONAL ALLOTMENT.
2. IMMEDIATELY AFTER HER ARRIVAL AMBASSADOR JEAN KENNEDY SMITH BEGAN A VIGOROUS PROGRAM OF IMPLEMENTING PRESIDENT CLINTON'S POLICY OF REVITALIZING US-IRISH BILATERAL RELATIONS AND PROMOTING PEACE AND RECONCILIATION BETWEEN THE PEOPLES OF THE REPUBLIC AND NORTHERN IRELAND. THIS POLICY DRAMATICALLY BORE FRUIT IN THE LATTER PART OF FY-1994. SINCE THE START OF FY-95 THE AMBASSADOR AND EMBASSY DUBLIN HAVE BEEN EXTENSIVELY INVOLVED IN FOLLOW UP ACTIVITIES TO ENSURE THAT THE PEACE PROCESS CONTINUES AND BECOMES PERMANENT. SUBSTANTIAL PUBLIC DIPLOMACY IS REQUIRED TO KEEP APACE WITH THE RAPID EVOLUTION OF THE IRISH SCENE. RECENT DEVELOPMENTS IN THE PAST THREE MONTHS INCLUDED, INTER ALIA, THE IRA LAYING DOWN ITS ARMS AND ENTERING THE POLITICIAL PROCESS, LOYALIST PARAMILITARIES DOING THE SAME, UNIONIST POLITICIANS ACCEPTING THE INEVITABILITY OF A POLITICIAL EXCHANGE WITH NATIONALIST PARTIES, AND AN ALL IRELAND PEACE AND RECONCILIATION FORUM COMMENCING TO MEET. THE FINAL STRAW THAT BROKE THE REPRESENTATION BACK WAS THE FALL OF THE REPUBLIC'S GOVERNMENT. AMBASSADOR SMITH AND HER STAFF MUST BE INFORMED OF ALL THESE NEW CIRCUMSTANCES. ANY OF THESE EVENTS INDIVIDUALLY WOULD JUSTIFY A SUBSTANTIAL ROUND OF NEW REPRESENTATIONAL EVENTS.

3- FORTUNATELY BECAUSE THESE EVENTS OCCURRED ALMOST SIMULTANEOUSLY WE WERE ABLE TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF ECONOMIES OF SCALE AND GOT SUBSTANTIAL MORE BANG FOR THE BUCK BY COMBINING MANY ACTIVITIES. BUT THE LAST 8 WEEKS HAVE LEFT THE REPRESENTATIONAL CUPBOARD BARE. WE NOW FACE A SECRETARY OF COMMERCE VISIT, SEVERAL PENDING CODELS AND THE INSTALLATION OF A NEW GOVERNMENT WITHOUT EVEN A BONE TO OFFER. WE WILL USE FCS, OTHER AGENCIES AND CONGRESSIONAL FUNDING TO THE MAXIMUM POSSIBLE BUT STILL WILL FALL SHORT. WE HAVE REQUESTED \$10,000 MORE IN REPRESENTATION THIS FY. IF POSSIBLE WE REQUEST THE FIRST HALF OF THAT BE APPROVED FOR IMMEDIATE DISBURSEMENT THIS QUARTER. NOLLAIG SHONA DUIT (MERRY CHRISTMAS) AND MANY THANKS FROM DUBLIN.

- b(4) Release would disclose trade secrets or confidential or financial information [(b)(4) of the FOIA]
- b(6) Release would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy [(b)(6) of the FOIA]
- b(7) Release would disclose information compiled for law enforcement purposes [(b)(7) of the FOIA]
- b(8) Release would disclose information concerning the regulation of financial institutions [(b)(8) of the FOIA]
- b(9) Release would disclose geological or geophysical information concerning wells [(b)(9) of the FOIA]
