1.1 Afghanistan : Defense has developed a target package that would consist of cruise missile strikes at two new UBL related camps near Jalalabad, Afghanistan and restrikes at missed facilities at Khowst. They hope in a few days to have finished planning for a B-2 strike at the Khowst cave complex. The rationale for these strikes would be:

--continue placing pressure on the Taliban to expel UBL network;

--continue to keep the UBL network off base, unable to know where they are safe to meet, plan, train;

--demonstrate that the US response on August 20th was not a "one off," but that the US is committed to destroying the UBL network; this demonstration of seriousness may motivate other nations to assist us.

DOD is also looking at two possible add-ons to an Afghan strike. The first would

While the facilities that could be hit may not be significant targets, striking them would benefit our attempts to paint UBL as "un-Islamic." 4. Diplomatic

On the public diplomacy front, Eric Schwartz and Jamie Metzl have been trying to orchestrate something to counter the Sudanese media blitz. They have had little support and report "no one in charge" of the effort for State. They did arrange a briefing by an INR DAS at the Foreign Media Center, but Metzl says it was so unconvincing that his mother (who attended) said after listening "My god, we bombed an ibuprofen plant."

5. Protection

The State DS teams have yet to report back on emergency relocation requirements.

As a result OMB is backing away from seeking funds for emergency relocations.

State may have decided to leave embassies at indefensible locations rather than move them to temporary complexes, given the lack of assurance that there will be "extra" money in the out years to build new embassies.

Numerous threat reports continue to come in. Where the sourcing looks credible, we have taken steps to close facilities, scale down, and/ or beef up security.

Several reports indicate UBL planning for an attack in Washington. We are dusting off response plans through a table top exercise, at the Attorney

General's request. These reports give added impetus to our requests for Secret Service upgrades, (b)(7)(D)

6. Pulling it Together

You should ask in the Small Group that JCS, CIA, and State produce written plans for the near and mid-term. Treasury and Justice can be tasked separately. The Planning Group can then bring these parts together into an integrated plan.

The near term decision that you should make on Tuesday is whether to recommend military strikes next weekend. I recommend you proceed with the Afghanistan package, including the B-2 raid and the add-ons. The facilities, taken one by one, may not be high value. We will not, however, ever again get the "Appalachian Conference" of terrorists and you should not use that as your standard. Given the Iranian pressure on Kabul, the timing may be good to build on alleged Saudi, Pakistani, and UAE pressure on the Taliban to expel UBL.

Subject: Update on Project

Summary: DOD has completed its analysis of currently available targets and could be ready to conduct strikes on Saturday (assuming a Wednesday go ahead).

Treasury is

moving ahead with identification of UBL related accounts in foreign banks and plans to pressure those nations and institutions. State, with Pickering and Ross out, did little last week on the diplomatic front or on public diplomacy.

1.1 Afghanistan : Defense has developed a target package that would consist of cruise missile strikes at two new UBL related camps near Jalalabad, Afghanistan and restrikes at missed facilities at Khowst. They hope in a few days to have finished planning for a B-2 strike at the Khowst cave complex. The rationale for these strikes would be:

--continue placing pressure on the Taliban to expel UBL network;

--continue to keep the UBL network off base, unable to know where they are safe to meet, plan, train;

--demonstrate that the US response on August 20th was not a "one off," but that the US is committed to destroying the UBL network; this demonstration of seriousness may motivate other nations to assist us.

DOD is also looking at two possible add-ons to an Afghan strike. The first would

be [redacted] (b)(1)

[redacted] While the facilities that could be hit may not be significant targets, striking them would benefit our attempts to paint UBL as "un-Islamic." The second add-on would be a warning shot near the Tarnak complex at Qandahar. The strike would warn residents of Tarnak to leave the UBL camp, as part of our efforts to keep the organization confused and off base.

You may also want to give some thought to planning, at least, strikes on Taliban high value targets to place pressure on them to give up UBL. There are so few UBL targets that we may be hard pressed to find something to attack following any additional UBL terrorism against us. We may, therefore, eventually have to strike directly at those who give him sanctuary.

1.2 Sudan: DOD could also launch attacks in Sudan. Three targets are available:

--UBL Companies: The tannery and the construction company are known to be wholly owned by UBL. While there are reports that they have been used as cover for other projects, there is no doubt that they are facilities engaged in tanning and building. The rationale for striking them would be to reduce his

(although not by much), but more importantly to send a message that
working with
or for UBL is dangerous.

Any decision on Sudan should involve a policy on the inspection
question. The
UNSC has not yet addressed the inspection issue. Some in State favor
offering
support for an inspection (by UNSCOM) of Shifa and other suspect
CW sites. They
believe Sudan would reject this proposal. In thinking about
inspections, you
should recall that:


--UNSCOM inspected the Iraqi VX site three times and gave it a clean
bill of
health, only to learn latter [redacted] (b)(1) that the site was

VX. Iraq later admitted it.



3. Treasury

As we had assumed, there have been few UBL related accounts identified in US

banks [redacted] (b)(1)

Treasury has gone out to other states and asked them to look for UBL related accounts. [redacted] (b)(1) issued an order to their banks to do so.

Until we give nations specifics about front companies and individuals, they are unlikely to produce much. Treasury/OFAC has given the project enthusiastic support [redacted] (b)(1)

Both [redacted] (b)(1) have promised me that they will act when we give them names. We are working with Treasury [redacted] (b)(1)

4. Diplomatic

State now sent another note to the Pakistanis for the Taliban. It was delivered not by the ambassador, but by the DCM who saw an "additional secretary" in the Foreign Ministry.

Rather than sending the Vice Presidential message to the Saudi Crown Prince and Egyptian President as we requested, State sent talking points to Ambassador Fowler who had scheduled a meeting already with Abdullah. [redacted]

On the public diplomacy front, Eric Schwartz and Jamie Metzl have been trying to orchestrate something to counter the Sudanese media blitz. They have

had little support and report "no one in charge" of the effort for State. They did arrange a briefing by an INR DAS at the Foreign Media Center, but Metzl says it was so unconvincing that his mother (who attended) said after listening "My god, we bombed an ibuprofen plant."

5. Protection

The State DS teams have yet to report back on emergency relocation requirements.

As a result OMB is backing away from seeking funds for emergency relocations.

State may have decided to leave embassies at indefensible locations rather than move them to temporary complexes, given the lack of assurance that there will be "extra" money in the out years to build new embassies.

Numerous threat reports continue to come in. Where the sourcing looks credible, we have taken steps to close facilities, scale down, and/ or beef up security.

Several reports indicate UBL planning for an attack in Washington. We are dusting off response plans through a table top exercise, at the Attorney

General's request. These reports give added impetus to our requests for Secret Service upgrades (b)(1)

6. Pulling it Together

You should ask in the Small Group that JCS, CIA, and State produce written plans for the near and mid-term. Treasury and Justice can be tasked separately. The Planning Group can then bring these parts together into an integrated plan.

The near term decision that you should make on Tuesday is whether to recommend military strikes next weekend. I recommend you proceed with the Afghanistan package, including the B-2 raid and the add-ons. The facilities, taken one by one, may not be high value. We will not, however, ever again get the

"Appalachian Conference" of terrorists and you should not use that as your standard. Given the Iranian pressure on Kabul, the timing may be good to build on alleged Saudi, Pakistani, and UAE pressure on the Taliban to expel UBL.
