SUBJECT: HUGE VAN BOMB DISCOVERED IN IRISH REPUBLIC

1. SUMMARY: A HUGE VAN BOMB, DISCOVERED IN COUNTY LOUTH IN THE IRISH REPUBLIC ON NOVEMBER 10,

WAS BELIEVED TO HAVE BEEN INTENDED FOR A SECURITY FORCE TARGET IN SOUTH ARMAGH. THE BOMB

CONTAINED 1,300 POUNDS OF HOME-MADE EXPLOSIVES. WE REPORT LOCAL REACTION. END SUMMARY.

2. DUP LEADER IAN PAISLEY SAID THAT THE DISCOVERY OF THE "REPUBLICAN-MADE" BOMB WAS EVIDENCE OF THE REPUBLICAN COMMUNITY'S WILLINGNESS TO USE TERRORISM AGAINST THE PEOPLE OF ULSTER. HE CALLED FOR MORE TROOPS TO BE INSTALLED ALONG THE BORDER WITH THE IRISH REPUBLIC.

3. FRINGE LOYALIST GROUPS SAW THE DISCOVERY AS A REASON NOT TO DECOMMISSION LOYALIST WEAPONS. GARY MCMICHAEL, LEADER OF THE ULSTER DEMOCRATIC PARTY SAID A SHADOW HAD BEEN CAST OVER THE PEACE PROCESS.

4. ULSTER UNIONIST LEADER DAVID TRIMBLE SAID HE WAS SUSPICIOUS ABOUT THE BOMB FIND AS IT CAME HARD ON THE HEELS OF REPUBLICAN CLAIMS THAT THE PEACE PROCESS WAS IN DANGER. HE OPINED THAT SINN FEIN HAD GIVEN THEIR BLESSING TO THE BOMB ATTEMPT.

5. SDLP DEPUTY LEADER SEAMUS MALLON SAID, "IT WILL

COME AS NO SURPRISE THAT THEY (REPUBLICAN SINN FEIN) ARE LOOKING AT THE PEACE PROCESS WITH ILL-INTENT BECAUSE THAT IS PART OF THEIR STOCK-IN-TRADE." HE ADDED THAT THE FIND SHOULD NOT SLOW DOWN THE PEACE PROCESS.

6. SINN FEIN SAID THE INCIDENT DEMONSTRATED THE NEED TO ADVANCE TO ALL-PARTY TALKS WITHOUT DELAY.

7. FOR THE GOVERNMENT, NORTHERN IRELAND SECRETARY SIR PATRICK MAYHEW SAID THE DISCOVERY DEMONSTRATED THE NEED FOR CONTINUING VIGILANCE. "IT VINDICATES OUR APPROACH OF A POSITIVE, FLEXIBLE YET MEASURED SECURITY RESPONSE TO THE CEASEFIRES
