Dear President Clinton:


We express our deep gratitude for your help in bringing about a cease fire in Ireland, which we believe will lead eventually to a just peace. Your help in this situation has been noted by many throughout the United States and will be remembered.

We also want to express our thanks for your intervention in the "Casement Accused" miscarriages of justice. Incidentally, "60 Minutes" will soon feature a segment on the Casement Accused. The producer, who has looked into these miscarriages of justice, said it is "a story that has to be told."

All major human rights groups worldwide have said similar things, as have many diverse groups such as the Association of Prison and Parole Officers in England. Irish Foreign Minister Dick Spring, members of the British, Irish and Australian parliaments, and over 60 members of the U.S. House of Representatives agree and have called for these cases to be brought back to the Court.

There is one more thing that would help immensely. A peace envoy to Northern Ireland would ensure that all parties, including the British government, which has been criticized by all major human rights organizations for its actions in Northern Ireland, will adhere to standards that will bring peace with justice for all.
